Dear Members of the Morgan ISD Community,

In keeping with Morgan ISD's practices to respond to COVID-19, we are notifying all student families and staff members that an individual has been lab-confirmed to test positive for COVID-19 and that individual was last present on campus on Friday, September 3, 2021.

As we carefully review, we believe we have traced all students, staff, or areas accessed by the individual who has tested positive or who may have come into "close contact" with that individual and made the proper arrangements for any necessary quarantining and disinfecting. We will keep you apprised of further updates.

If any students and/or staff did come in close contact with the individual who tested positive, they will be contacted directly by a school administrator within 24-48 hours.

While we do not have reason to believe that those who were not in close contact with the infected individual(s) have reason to be concerned, we ask that you, as always, watch for symptoms of COVID-19.

Any of the following symptoms indicate a possible COVID-19 infection:

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth;
- Sore throat;
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline);
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

If you or any member of the Morgan ISD community does begin experiencing any of these symptoms in a way that is not typical, we encourage you to contact your physician.
