



Job Description: Science Teacher and Girls Coach

Primary Purpose:

Provide instruction and coach students to develop skills and ability to excel in sport assigned. Provide science students with learning activities and experiences designed to help them fulfill their potential for intellectual, emotional, physical, and social growth.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree from accredited college or university
- Valid Texas teaching certificate with Science, or current enrollment in a Texas teacher certification program
- General knowledge of coaching techniques and procedures
- Knowledge of University Interscholastic League (UIL) rules
- Ability to instruct and supervise student athletes
- Excellent organizational, communication and interpersonal skills

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- Prepare and deliver content-based lessons for science courses in grades 9-12.
- Plan and use appropriate instructional and learning strategies, activities, materials and equipment that reflect understanding of the learning styles and needs for students assigned.
- Work with other members of school staff to plan and implement instructional goals and objectives to ensure the overall educational development of students.
- Keep informed of, and ensure compliance with, all UIL athletic competition rules.
- Manage and supervise athletic activities, contest and practice sessions to promote individual growth in athletic skills, teamwork and good sportsmanship.
- Accompany and supervise student athletes during athletic competitions in assigned sports on out-of-town trips.
- Encourage, by example and through instruction, sportsmanlike conduct in all phases of athletic participation.
