

Elmore City-Pernell Public Schools – Bond Election History

September 19, 2000 Election – \$500,000 Combined Purpose Bonds

- **Proposition No. 1 – \$200,000 (Transportation)**
 - Buses
 - 235 in Favor and 289 were Against; Total 344 – Passed 68.31%
 - **Proposition No. 2 – \$300,000 (Building)**
 - Renovations – HVAC, floor coverings, painting, ceiling tiles, furniture and equipment
 - 238 in Favor and 110 were Against; Total 348 – Passed 68.39%
 - Projected Tax Increase – 15.77%
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August 24, 2004 Election – \$1,950,000 Series Building Bonds

- New Elementary Classroom Building with Cafeteria/Kitchen
 - New Classroom Building at HS Campus
 - 648 in Favor and 289 were Against; Total 937 – Passed 69.16%
 - Projected Tax Increase – 15.66%
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August 28, 2012 Election – \$250,000 Transportation Bonds

- Buses
 - 191 in Favor and 95 were Against; Total 286 – Passed 69.16%
 - Projected No Tax Increase
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September 10, 2013 Election – \$7,510,000 Series Building Bonds

- New Gymnasium and Renovation of HS
 - 207 in Favor and 340 were Against; Total 547 – Failed 37.84%
 - Projected Tax Increase – 17.03%
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August 26, 2014 Election – \$2,275,000 Building Bonds

- New Middle School with Safe Room/Band Room
- 378 in Favor and 242 were Against; Total 620 – Passed 61.03%
- Projected Tax Increase – 8.00%
