If you check both basketball and wrestling, please circle your first choice. This means, if you are not selected for your first choice, you still would be a cheerleader in the other sport if you are the next highest score.

I understand my obligations if I am selected as a cheerleader, and I will obey all guideline rules. I understand the time, commitment, and expense involved in being a cheerleader. I understand that I must be eligible by Oklahoma Secondary Schools Activity Association Policy on the day of tryouts, all dues must be paid and all uniforms from previous seasons must be checked in, in order to participate in cheerleading tryouts.

CHEERLEADING TRYOUTS

Tryouts will be held as close to the last nine weeks as possible and will be scheduled by the coach and the administration.

Students trying out for cheerleader will learn and perform a cheer, chant and two jumps. Those wishing to cheer for wrestling may also be required to learn 1-2 wrestling cheers and perform those with time permitting in front of the judges.

Each student trying out must have the completed form signed by a parent giving permission by deadline.

Each must have read and understand the cheerleading regulations

Tryouts are **CLOSED** to the public. NO students, parents, friends, relatives or any other person may enter the gym on the day of tryouts. The gym will be locked once tryouts have begun. Only the judges, coaches and Senior Cheerleaders leading the clinic will be allowed in the gym. Score tabulators may be allowed at the discretion of the coaches and will be chosen by the coaches.

In selection of the cheerleading squads, the teachers/coaches will complete an evaluation of the cheerleaders overall performance, ability, attitude and leadership. The evaluation will make up 20% of the final score.

In the event of a tie, contestants may be asked to perform a second time in front of the judges. Judges will break all ties and their decision will be final.

Winners will be posted on the landing room window about an hour after the judges are finished and scores are tabulated. Judges, coaches or seniors that taught the clinic may not be contacted for specific information or questioning about tryouts. All decisions are final once they have been posted.
