VI. Business

a. Indian Policies and Procedures (IPPS)

Pawnee Public Schools has established Indian Policies and Procedures as required by the Impact Aid law, which ensures that all of our Native American children have equal access to all programs, services and activities offered within the school district. The Title VI Parent Committee has reviewed the Indian Policies and Procedures.

Warren Pratt made a motion to approve the Indian Policies and Procedures, second by Kacie Spears. All in favor, motion carried.

b. Oklahoma School Testing Results

Last year state administered a more complex assessment. The scores reflect redefined proficiency expectations. Oklahoma assessment scores now track for college and career readiness, align with the SAT and ACT assessments. These scores cannot be compared to previous years, since they are no longer being assessed at the same level as they were in prior years. This year we see a decrease in the number of Title VI students who score proficient or higher due to the new redefined proficiency expectations, but we also expect steady growth in test scores in the coming years.

c. Activities

T-Shirt fundraiser- Warren Pratt would like to sell native designed t-shirts as a fundraiser, possibly Northern Plains Indian Club t-shirts. He has the design.

On December 13, 2017, the Pawnee Nation Elders will be having their Christmas meal. They have asked if some of our students could come to help serve and sing. Warren cannot attend but he will prepare the students and Vicki Pratt will take them upon approval by administration.
