TDAP IMMUNIZATION

The State Department of Health now requires **ALL students entering 7th grade** to have a TDAP Booster. If you are the parent or guardian of a **6th grade** student, you may want to schedule an appointment for the vaccine soon in order to avoid the rush in August. **Students will not be allowed to attend 7th grade next school year until proof of the TDAP vaccine has been provided to the middle school office.**

OHLAP-Oklahoma's Promise

Students in grades 8-11 may sign up for OHLAP-Oklahoma's Promise. This is a college scholarship that pays tuition for students whose parents' federal adjusted gross income is below \$60,000. You may sign up online at www.okhighered.org/okpromise/. This is a wonderful opportunity for kids to attend college that might not otherwise be able to afford it. There are certain guidelines and/or classes that you must take. This can easily amount to roughly \$25,000. Please let Ms. Cantrell (Middle School and High School Counselor) know when your application is complete and accepted.
