Student or staff should isolate and stay home for at least 7 days after testing positive AND they are fever free for 72 hours AND other symptoms have improved.

Student or staff should isolate and stay home for at least 7 days after testing positive AND they are fever free for 72 hours AND other symptoms have improved.

Student or staff can return to school or work after at least 3 days of being symptom free after the date of the negative test.

If not tested, the student or staff may return to school or work after the 14-day self-quarantine.
If tested negative, the student or staff can return to school or work 3 days after the negative test-provided no symptoms begin.

CLOSE contact is defined as living in the same home or a person one spent more than an hour within the same room.

Decision to close school.

Did a student or staff member test positive for COVID 19?

Was the student or staff at school within 72 hours of testing positive?

There will be no school closure & school will be cleaned as designated.

There is no evidence of community spread.

YES

In conjunction with the Oklahoma Health Department, school would remain open after sanitizing ALL areas the staff or student had spent more than 30 minutes OR Superintendent may close school for 24 hours to give adequate time for sanitization.
School closure MAY be made up.

YES

There is minimum evidence of community spread.

YES

In conjunction with the Oklahoma Health Department, school will be closed for a minimum of 2 days to 2 weeks to ensure no other social contacts become infected. During this time the students will participate in distance learning.
School closure would not be made up through additional days, but students would be in distance learning.

YES

There is moderate or significant evidence of community spread.

YES

In conjunction with the Oklahoma Health Department, school will be closed for a long-term period of 10 days or longer.
Students would continue school through distance learning.
The school closure would not be made up through additional days but through participation in distance learning.

Is the exposure to COVID 19 limited to one site?

YES

Only the site of the exposure will be closed. The other sites will remain open to students and staff. The Superintendent will set the closure time.

NO

The entire district will be closed until such time designated by the Superintendent.
