## August

Review high school transcript  
Begin resume, activities chart  
Know requirements for graduation,  
BOR admissions, State Scholar,  
NCAA/NAIA  
Know requirements for out-of-state  
schools  
Request college information (mailing  
list)  
Register at Fastweb and  
Scholarships.com  
Register NCAA/NAIA if you have not  
done so already

## September

Begin reviewing colleges  
Talk with your parents about college

## October

Take the practice ACT, ASVAB, or  
PSAT/NMSQT on Test Day October 16

## November, December

Prepare for the ACT  
Attend Future's Fair at Century II  
October 5, 6

## January

Begin to narrow down your college  
choices  
Review admissions requirements for  
potential schools  
Visit colleges  
Visit with admission representatives  
when they come to ACHS (Jan-April)

## February

Last chance to take ACT if taking dual  
credit classes in summer or senior  
year  
Enroll for senior year

## March, April

Don't get Spring Fever!!  
Think of community service activities  
and jobs for summer.

## May

Take AP Tests  
Plan your summer

Visit college campuses  
Organize deadlines and information  
Begin applying to colleges

# Senior Checklist

## August

Review transcript and grad requirements  
Register for Parchment account  
Narrow college choices  
Visit college campuses  
Register- [www.fastweb.com](http://www.fastweb.com) and [www.scholarships.com](http://www.scholarships.com)  
Register NCAA/NAIA if you have not done so already

## September

Visit admission representatives when they visit ACHS  
Register for ACT or SAT if you haven't done so or if you want to improve your score  
Know tests, dates, fees, deadlines for your college choices  
Complete resume, activities chart, personal statement  
Begin application and scholarship process

## October

October 1<sup>st</sup> priority deadline for WSU  
Take ACT/SAT  
ASVAB on Test Day if you would like  
Check on housing application  
Visit final college choices

## November

November 1<sup>st</sup> priority deadline (KU & KSU)

## December

Request PIN for FAFSA  
([www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov))

Print FAFSA worksheet

([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov))

Complete admissions applications

Take ACT one final time if needed

## January

Complete and submit FAFSA as soon as possible  
Send mid-year transcripts and reports if needed

## February

Continue with scholarship applications  
Check status of FAFSA  
([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) or 1-800-433-3243)

## March

Financial aid award letter may be coming

## April

Preview financial aid award letters  
Make final college decision, send in deposit  
Notify other colleges of your decision.

## May

Take AP Tests  
Send final transcripts—high school and college (ie. Butler)  
Graduate!
