

# Class Registration 2018-2019

**Dates: February 14-26**

- Review enrollment guide and graduation requirements.
- Check college admissions requirements.
- Logon to PowerSchool at [www.usd385.org](http://www.usd385.org) and click on the Guardians/Students PowerSchool link to log into your account.
- Click on the Class Registration icon.
- Follow the directions carefully.
- Pay attention to prerequisite notes. If you do not meet pre-requisites, the computer will not allow you to select the class.
- Pick the number of classes allowed.
- The computer will not allow you to leave blanks unless instructed to do so.
- If you are picking year-long electives, make sure you pick both semesters – watch the numbers.
- **DO NOT REPEAT CLASSES IN THE ALTERNATE SECTION THAT YOU HAVE ALREADY PICKED FOR YOUR FIRST CHOICE!** Alternate classes should be entirely different classes.
- When done, click on the submit button. If you did everything as instructed, it will accept your requests. If you left something blank that was not supposed to be left blank, it will not accept any of your choices.
- To view your requests hit the View Future Course Requests link on the class registration screen.

See counselor if you are unable to pick the classes you need or you have technology issues. Remember, you can now view your graduation progress in PowerSchool by clicking on the Grade History icon then View Graduation Progress.
