

Halliburton Employees' Federal Credit Union will be accepting applications for the 10th Annual Devon Stricklin Memorial Scholarship and for the 1st Annual Wynona (Nona) Driskell Scholarship. Each scholarship will benefit one high school senior who is a member of Halliburton Employees' Federal Credit Union. Each scholarship will be awarded during the student's freshman year in two installments of \$500 per semester. Student must provide proof of enrollment for each semester prior to the scholarship being awarded.

Each student's entry will be judged on the following criteria:

- Academic Achievement and other honors 50%
- Extracurricular Activities, Community Participation 30%
- Essay 20 %

Scholarship Guidelines:

- Applicant must have their own account with Halliburton Employees' Federal Credit Union.
- Immediate family members of employees or board/supervisory committee are not eligible to apply for the Devon Stricklin Memorial Scholarship or the Wynona (Nona) Driskell Scholarship.
- Applicant must be a senior currently enrolled in high school and must be entering an accredited university as a full-time student (12 hours).
- Scholarship will be issued in the name of the recipient and the college they plan to attend.

Applicants Need to Submit:

- Completed Scholarship Application including attached essay
- High School Transcript
- Copy of ACT/SAT Score
- Completely filled out application form
