

PICK UP PROCEDURES: BLINKERS & TRAFFIC SAFETY

In an effort to keep our students safe please read and follow these pick up procedures. Please use your blinker as you enter and exit the car line in the afternoon. SAFETY ISSUE: The North Lot is designated for PARENT PICKUP. The South Lot is designated for DAYCARE PICKUP.
