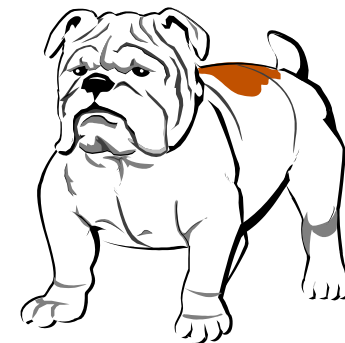

Improvements to YPS

The bond issues will provide for our students what we would not be able to purchase without the community's support, and our students deserve our support.

Construction/Equipment Bond

- Construct a building that will serve as a show barn, school farm and concession stand which will also be utilized for baseball/softball
- \$40,000 for new band instruments
- Shelter for the busses
- A new digital sign in front of the high school

Transportation Bond

This bond will be used to purchase the following items:

- One school suburban-type vehicle

What It Will Cost You

The number one question with a bond is "What will it cost me?" The following taxpayer cost analysis was provided by the Stephen L. Smith Corporation.

NO Tax Increase

It replaces the transportation bond of 2015 that is paid in full .

All registered voters in the Yale school district are eligible to vote in this election.

Bond Breakdown

- The overall cost of the bond is \$650,000.
- The transportation portion is \$45,000.

School Show Barn/School Farm with bathroom and concession stand to also be used for baseball and softball

This building will be 4,000 sq. ft. and cost \$94 per sq. ft.
