



Outdoor Adventures Equipment Funds

APPLICATION GUIDELINES – Revised 7-1-2017

- **Award Range:** \$1000 maximum for 2017 (\$2000 maximum for Travis County and all joining counties)
- **Available Funding:** Funding levels are approved by the Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation Board of Trustees. The amount of total funds for equipment will be approved by the OTF Board at the beginning of each fiscal year. The total number of recipients each year will vary based on the actual dollar requests of the equipment as well as the total funds available in the funding year. Funding for 2016 is provided by Cabela's Outdoor Fund.
- **Application Deadlines:** All applications are due on the first day of each month.
- **Notification of Recipients:** Approximately two weeks from the scheduled Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation Board of Trustees monthly meeting.
- **Project Duration:** The project duration is 12 months. Any unexpended funds will revert to the Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation at the end of the 12-month period. **All proof of purchase or copy of Purchase Orders must be provided to the OTF during the project 12 month period.**
- **Applicant Eligibility:** Funds are limited to OTF Outdoor Adventures education programs in good standing. Purchase of the Outdoor Adventures education curriculum is required before application process begins. All equipment funds are matching funds. Applicants must have an approved purchase order for the equipment in order to be considered for equal/matching funds from the Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation's Outdoor Adventures education program. Or, the school must show proof of purchase of outdoor education equipment prior to purchasing the curriculum. This will ensure at least \$1000 in equipment was purchased for the program.
- **Eligible Equipment:** All equipment to be purchased must be approved for instruction in the Outdoor Adventures education curriculum.
- **Proposal Review:** Proposals shall be objectively reviewed by the OTF Board. Prior to submittal, the teachers' principal's signature and qualified school administrator is required.
- **Equipment Ownership, Warranty and Liability:** All equipment purchased for the Outdoor Adventures education program with the Outdoor Adventures Equipment Fund will be using matching funds. All equipment ownership, equipment warranties, maintenance and liability will transfer to the receiving school district. The Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation will not be held liable for the equipment warranties and maintenance. It will be the responsibility of the school district and the employees trained for the specific equipment use, to maintain the equipment and the proper utilization of the equipment. If a school district decides to cancel the Outdoor Adventures program, the school district may approach the Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation to purchase the equipment at a depreciated value.
