

## Malta ISD Extracurricular Activity Policy

### Malta ISD extracurricular activities include –

- **Drama Club**

Malta ISD encourages all eligible students to participate in extracurricular activities that can enhance their student achievement and overall enjoyment of their school experience. Extracurricular activities are a privilege and not a right. Students participating in extracurricular activities will be held at a higher standard than just the regular student. Students participating in extracurricular activities are a direct reflection of our school when they are performing or on school sponsored trips and activities. These students will be expected to follow the same rules that would apply during the normal school hours and that are outlined in the Student Handbook as well as the Student Code of Conduct. Malta ISD reserves the right to dismiss any student from extracurricular activities based on certain disciplinary circumstances. The extracurricular sponsor or the principal will notify the parent in writing if a student officially becomes eligible for removal from an extracurricular activity. Reasons for dismissal from an extracurricular activity for the remainder of a school year include any of the following–

- 3 Formal Disciplinary Referrals to the Principal
- 2 ISS/Paddling Offenses
- 1 DAEP Offense

Students will also have to abide by the grade standards set forth by Malta ISD. Students will have to maintain the passing standard of 70 or above in all of their classes to be eligible to participate in an extracurricular activity. Students who fail a class are not eligible to stay for after school practices and participate in performances until they become academically eligible again.
