Ticket Sales and Procedures for Sr. High Football Games

In order to be in compliance with the Department of Health and AAA guidelines for outside venue activities, there will be several changes to procedures concerning Lion Football home games for the 2020-2021 season. The Lion Football season will kickoff with the first game on August 28 at 7:00 pm vs. Cutter Morning Star. Below are the procedures for purchasing tickets and the AAA guidelines that will be in place during the games.

- AAA is limiting the attendance to 66% of maximum seating capacity. This will allow for 396 tickets for the home side and 264 tickets for the visitors side at the stadium. There are also seating areas behind both end zones, and along the fence on both sides of the stadium for those choosing to bring a lawn chair.
- Priority will be given to family members of Lion football players. Each player will be allowed to purchase up to four tickets for family members. Coach DJ Keithley will be relaying this message to the players.
- A presale of tickets will go on sale starting Tuesday and will run through Thursday. Tickets may be purchased at the High School Office from 7:35-4:00. We encourage anyone purchasing tickets to use correct change when purchasing tickets in order to cut down on the spread of germs.
- Tickets will be \$5 each. Students/Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult.

- Any tickets left over will be available for purchase at the ticket booth on Friday, but will be on a first come, first serve basis. Once we reach capacity on ticket sales, no other tickets will be sold.
- Anyone entering must have a ticket, or a 2020-2021 AAA pass.
- AAA guidelines, along with a mandate from the Governor will require anyone who enters to wear a mask. Masks must be worn at all times, and throughout the game. Anyone who refuses to wear a mask will be asked to leave, and no refund will be issued. We will not provide masks at the ticket booth.
- AAA guidelines will require social distancing between family groups. Six foot markers will be on the ground near ticket booths, concession stand, restrooms, stands, and seating areas around the field to assist with social distancing.
