- The Campus Leadership Team along with parents and other stakeholders shall jointly develop, review and/or revise the Parent Engagement Policy periodically to meet the changing needs of the parents and school. It will be reviewed/communicated to parents biannually, and provided in a format and language the parents can understand. The LEA will provide the Parent and Family Engagement Policy, School Compacts, and “Parent’s Right to Know” letter in Spanish and other languages as needed.
- An annual Title I meeting will be held to discuss the Title I Schoolwide program and the parents’ right to be involved. Informational materials and campus events will be provided through newsletters, invitations, School Marquee, school/district websites, during the year designed to help parents work with their children to improve their children’s achievement. Materials will be provided in a format and language the parents can understand.
- The campus will build capacity by providing program opportunities for parents to actively engage with the children and teachers. Meetings will be scheduled in an attempt to provide parents opportunities to attend. Special provisions will be made for parents with limited English proficiency and/or with disabilities.
- Parents will be involved in the school plan, Title I, Part A programs as well as helping implement and coordinate parent programs that build ties through the Campus Leadership Team, surveys, teacher/parent meetings, and open forums to determine the effectiveness of the parent engagement program. Throughout the year, parents will be provided information on the following:
 - Title I, Part A Parent and Family Engagement Policy
 - School performance (Campus Improvement Plan) forms of assessment used to measure student progress, including State and local
 - School curriculum, content standards, proficiency levels students are expected to meet
 - workshops on improving parent teacher communication
- The Title I administrative staff will provide the coordination, technical assistance, parent resource centers and other reasonable support necessary to assist Liberty-Eylau Elementary in planning and implementing parent engagement activities. The district will educate teachers and other district staff in communicating and working with parents as equal partners.
