## RE: Required Immunizations for the 2018-2019 School Year

Dear Parents/Guardians of Students in Texas Schools, Kindergarten through 12th Grade:

State law requires students in Texas schools to be immunized against certain vaccine-preventable diseases. This letter is to inform you of where you can obtain information about which vaccines your child needs to attend school and also to remind you to get your child's vaccinations early—before the busy back-to-school season. Getting your child vaccinated not only protects your child's health, but also that of the community.

To determine the specific vaccines that are required for your child's grade level, please refer to the Texas Minimum State Vaccine Requirements for Students in Grades K-12. This document is available on the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Immunization Unit website at <a href="https://www.ImmunizeTexas.com">www.ImmunizeTexas.com</a>. If you are unsure of where your child can receive vaccines, contact your health-care provider or local health department. Without the proper documentation of required vaccinations or a valid medical or conscientious exemption, students will not be allowed to attend school.
