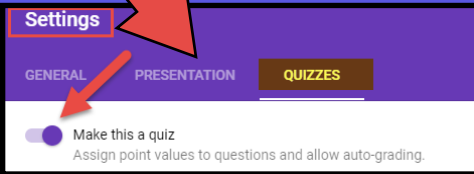

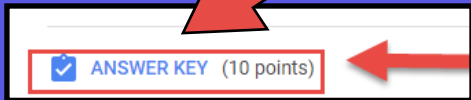

An easy way to create citations and bibliography lists. It also supports different formats including MLA, and APA.

### KAIZENA

### LUCIDCHART DIAGRAMS

Create and insert mind maps, diagrams, flowcharts right into your document.

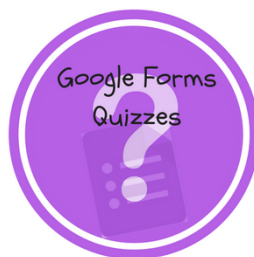
# Digital Portfolios
