

## Highland Park ISD Title I Program

- The school receives Title I funds based on the number of students who qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch.
- The higher the percentage of Free and Reduced Lunch students, the more Title I funds the school receives.
- The funds are used to improve the academic achievement of students who need timely additional assistance.
- Our school is Title I School-wide so the funds can be used for all kids
- We currently use funds to aid in the transition of children from pre-school to elementary school and to provide additional instructional support to those in need.
- Parent Involvement is a key part of being a Title I school. We are required to work with parents as partners in the education of our students.
- We also use other Title funds to provide teacher and principal training and recruitment (Title II) as well as to provide resources for Limited English Proficient students (Title III)
