### **Chaparral Women's Club 2018 College Scholarships**

Chaparral Women's Club is pleased to announce that we are sponsoring two (2) scholarships for Williamson County high school seniors graduating in 2018. Eligible schools include any public high school in Williamson County. The selection criteria are outlined below.

This scholarship is intended for use to continue education beyond High School in the form of a 4-year College or University, Trade School or Community College.

Scholarship recipients will be notified by the end of April 2018 and will be recognized at the schools' award ceremonies. Applicants not receiving scholarships will not be contacted. Disbursement will be made directly to the recipients' educational institution.

Applications must be filled out in its entirety. Applications missing signatures, sealed transcripts, test scores or letters of recommendation will be dismissed. If a section is not applicable, please note "n/a".
