Granger ISD Statement – Governors New COVID orders and masks

Governor Abbott had a press conference on 03/02/2021 about businesses reopening to 100% and rescinding the statewide mandate for wearing masks on March 10, 2021. At this time, Granger ISD will continue to follow the guidance of the Williamson County and Cities Health District (WCCHD) to continue to wear masks and social distance while at school.

WCCHD Guidance statement; "In light of recent announcements from Gov. Abbott, we wanted to let you know that our recommendations regarding masks and social distancing have not changed. Although the vaccines and downward trend of cases provide an optimistic outlook for the future, it is imperative that we maintain a high level of caution given the high level of community transmission of COVID-19 in Williamson County," from the Offices of the Epidemiologist of WCCHD.

As always, this guidance is ever changing, and we will continue to monitor the situation and current guidance from the county as well as the Texas Education Agency. The safety of our students and staff are of utmost importance to us and we will continue to work with the county to provide our school community with the best guidance possible.
