PBIS Cool Tool: Cyberbullying

Cyber bullying happens on web sites, in chat rooms, in blogs, through e-mail, on voicemail, and through text messages. The definition of cyberbullying is the use of different forms of technology to hurt, embarrass, or ridicule a person. A cyberbully can be a schoolmate, former friend, or complete stranger. Here are some steps you can take to prevent cyberbullying:

- Ignore the bully. You do not have to respond to a bully's text or email.
- Block messages. Block email addresses, screen names, or phone numbers
- You're not alone. Talk to a trusted adult.
- Save threatening emails or texts to help identify the bully
- If threats are made, ask an adult to call the police.
