Our mission here at WMS is to encourage students to learn to the best of their ability. We believe they should and can learn the value of thinking independently and never be satisfied with mediocre work. Therefore, we are offering a more challenging curriculum for students who have exemplified the fortitude, capability, and excitement needed to pursue the challenges of a Pre-AP class. The classes will work to deepen and strengthen conceptual understanding while making connections to past and future learning.

Students will be eligible for Pre-AP classes using various criteria, thereby demonstrating capabilities and skills needed to insure success in an advanced classroom setting. **The following is a list of the basic criteria, which will be considered when selecting students:**

1. Final average for the year in 6th grade must be **90% or higher** for appropriate subject.
2. STAR Math score must be **9th grade or higher** for Pre-AP Math and Pre-AP Science; STAR Reading score must be **9th grade or higher** for Pre-AP English and Pre-AP Social Studies.
3. Work ethic, attitude, and organizational skills are vital.
4. Teacher recommendation is **required** for any Pre-AP placement.

Pre-AP classes will involve a great deal of effort and self-discipline. The instruction will be rigorous and fast-paced.
