As we have worked through the start of the school year, Flatonia ISD administration has kept a close eye on enrollment numbers, including both in-person and remote learners. As of Tuesday, September 29, FISD has 601 enrolled students in grades PK through 12. Specific campus enrollment numbers and modes of instruction are as follows:
