### **Who are WatchDOGS (Dads Of Great Students)?**

WatchDOGS are fathers, grandfathers, uncles, and other father-figures who volunteer for at least one day each year at C-4 Elementary. During the day, WatchDOGS may read and work on flash cards with students, play at activity time, eat lunch with students, watch the school entrances and hallways, assist with traffic flow and any other assigned activities where they actively engage with not only their own students, but other students as well.
