Texas Performance Reporting System

The Texas Performance Reporting System (TPRS) integrates state and federal reporting requirements into a single reporting system that can be viewed at the campus, district, region, and state level. As the most comprehensive reporting system published by TEA, TPRS provides additional performance reports, results, and indicators for student groups not previously reported on state accountability data tables, the Texas Academic Performance Reports (TAPR), or the School Report Card.

Most of the TPRS STAAR reports contain data for Texas students who participated in statewide test administrations who are also in the accountability subset, which are students enrolled in the same campus on both the snapshot date (PEIMS Fall Snapshot) and the testing date. (For more information on accountability subset, see Chapter 1 of the Accountability manual.)

The TPRS Glossary specifies when accountability subset is used, provides definitions, describes methodologies, and lists sources for each tab in the TPRS system. The TPRS Glosario provides the Spanish translation of the glossary.

The Texas Research Portal contains data for all Texas students who participated in statewide test administrations. This data is available to analyze state assessment results. State assessment results within the Research Portal may vary slightly from the data used for accountability calculations as specified in accountability rules.

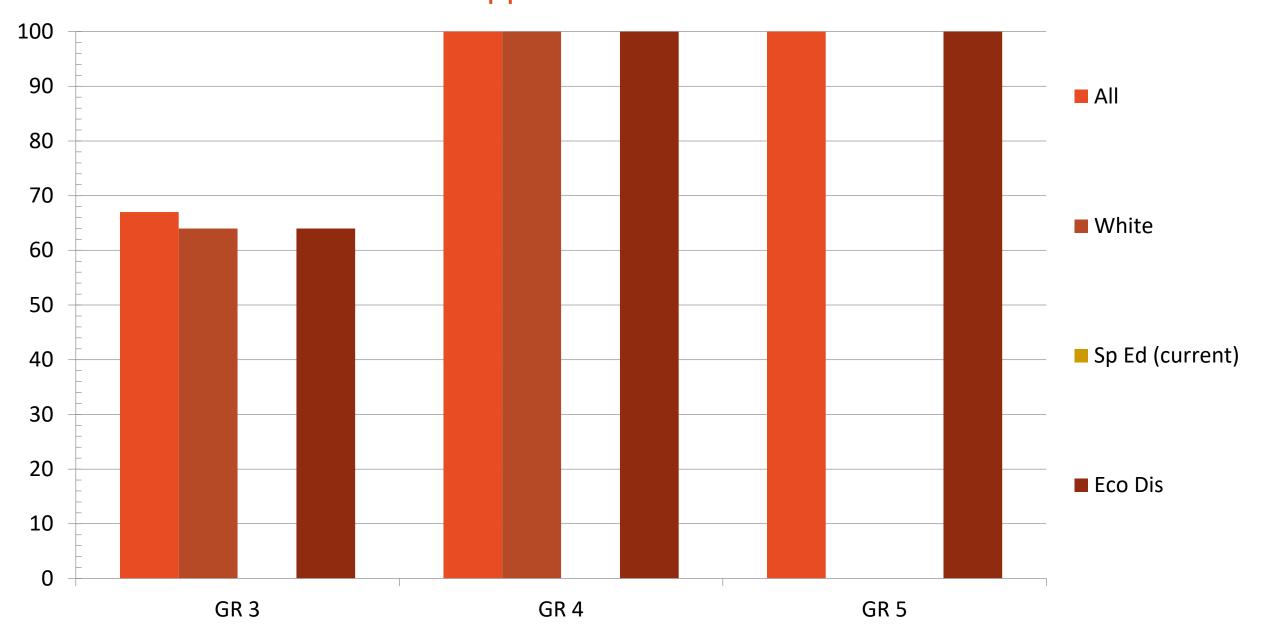

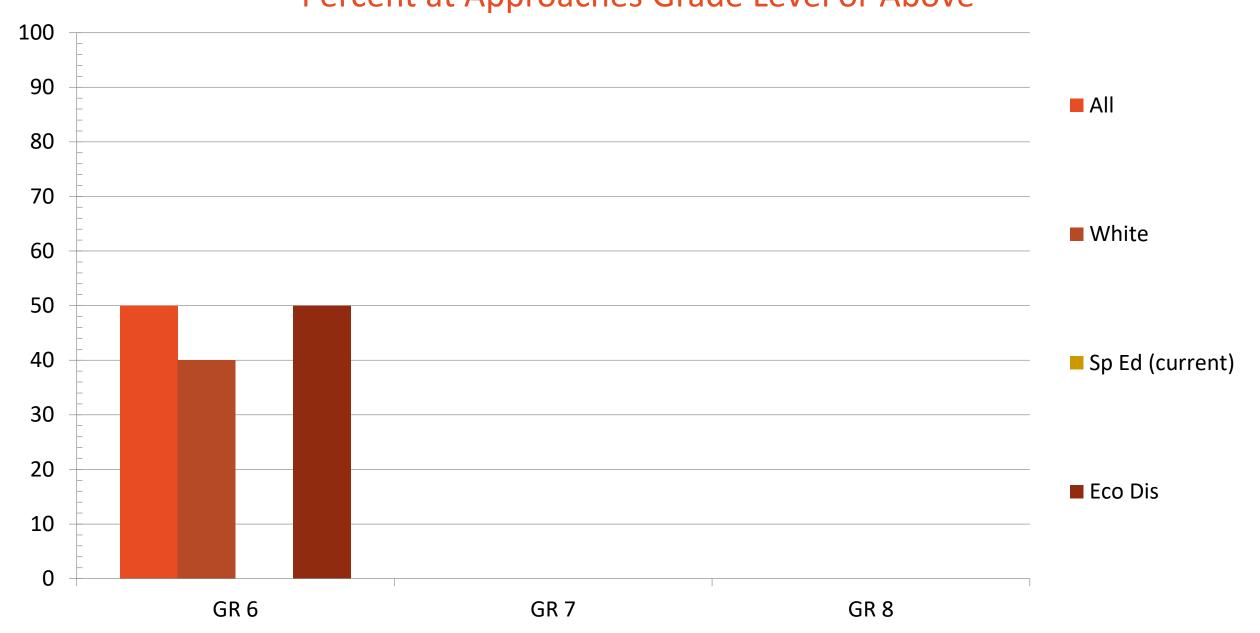

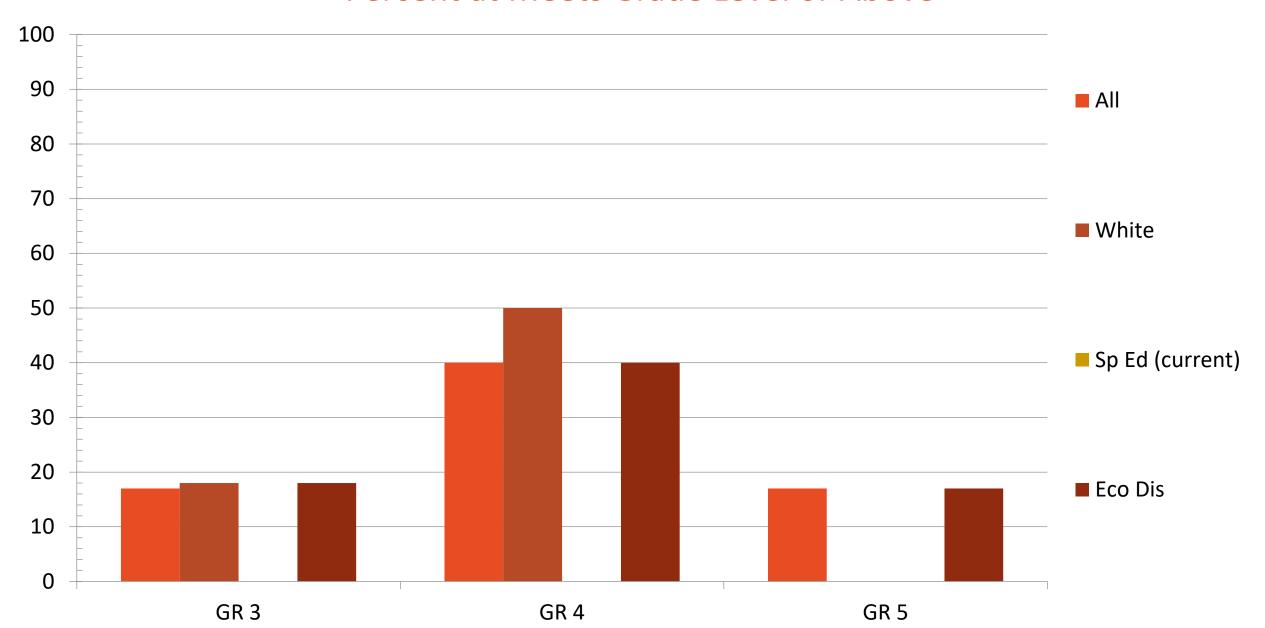
2024 STAAR 3-8 Reading Performance Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



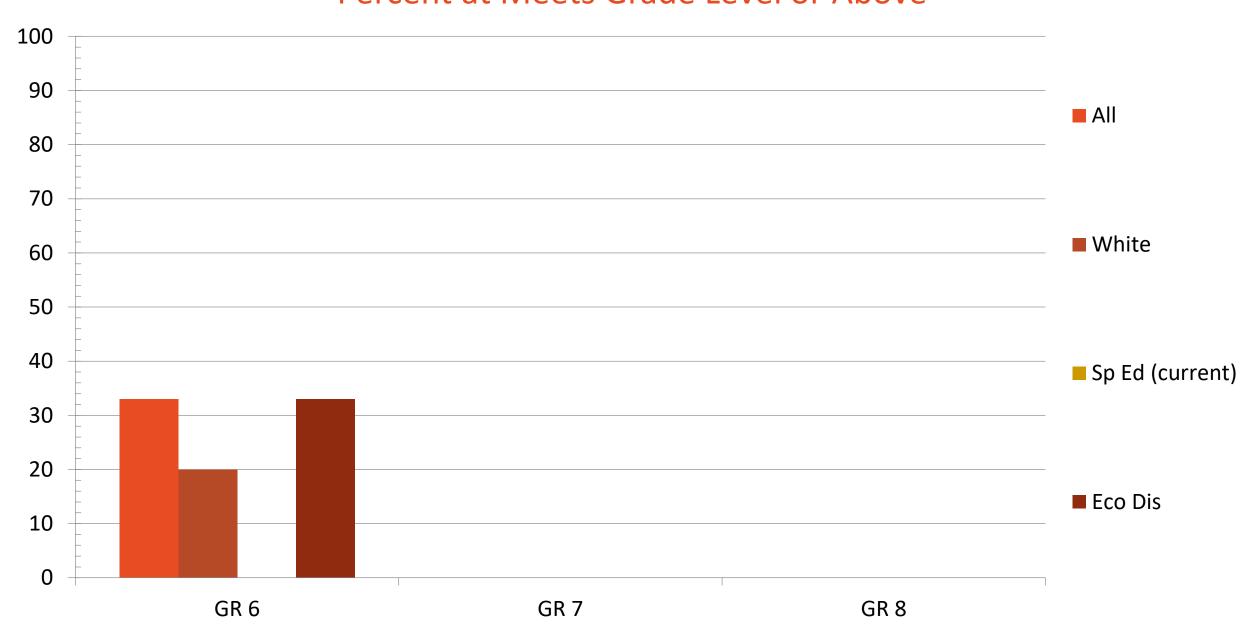
2024 STAAR 3-8 Reading Performance Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



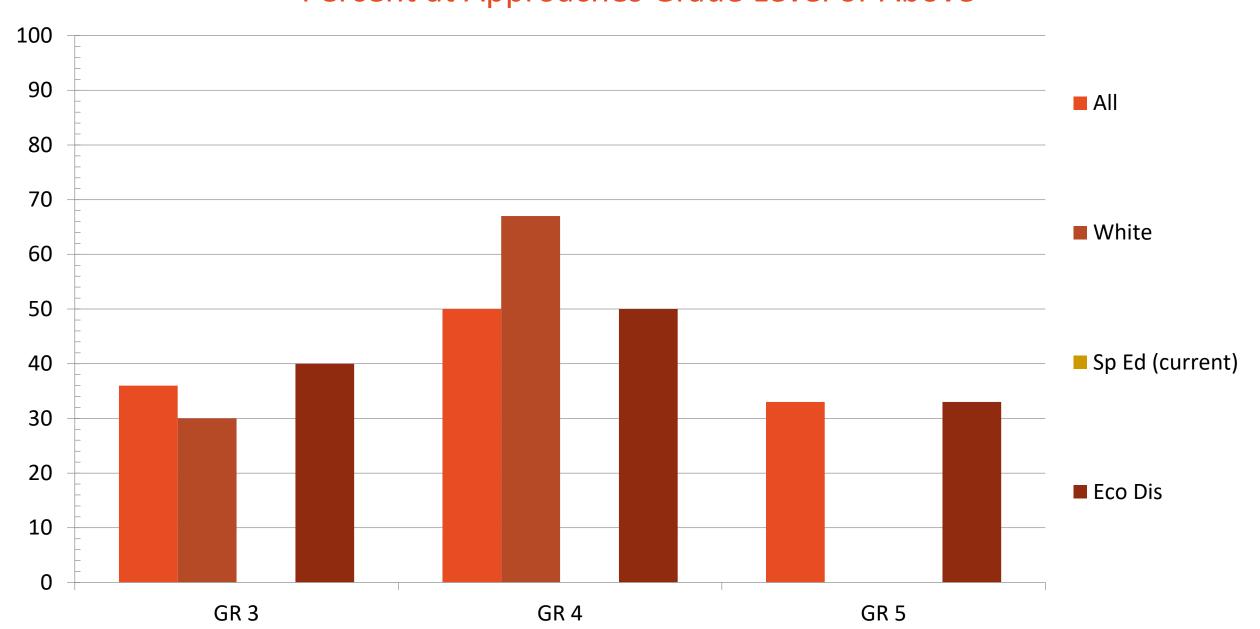
2024 STAAR 3-8 Reading Performance Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above



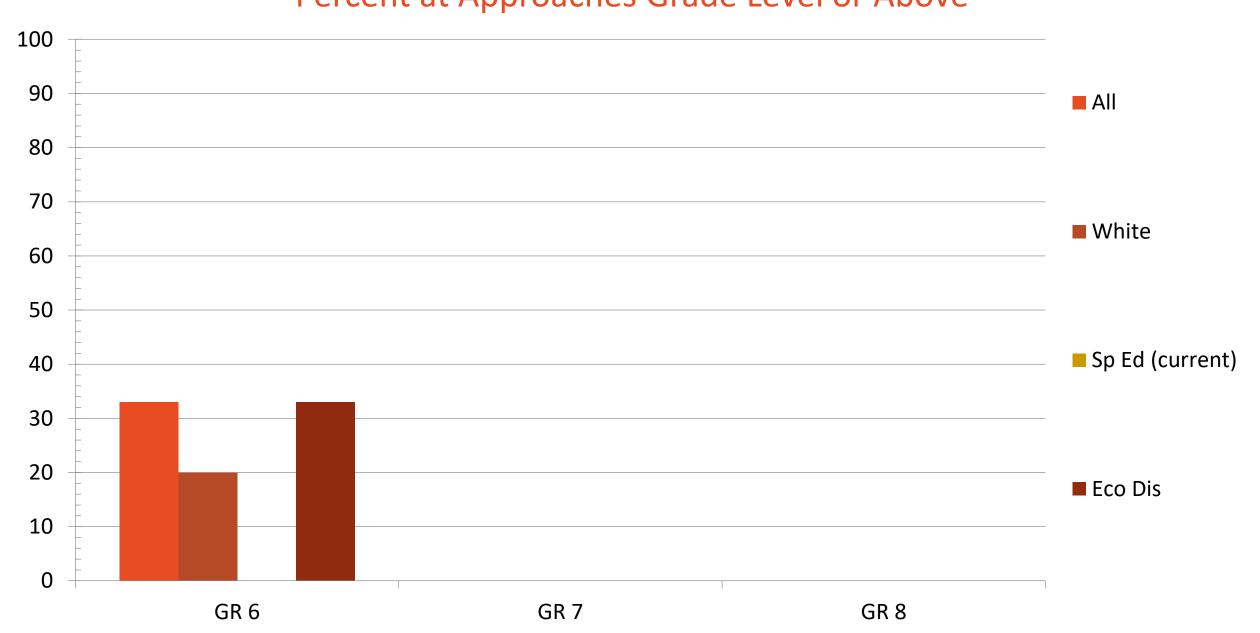
2024 STAAR 3-8 Reading Performance Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above



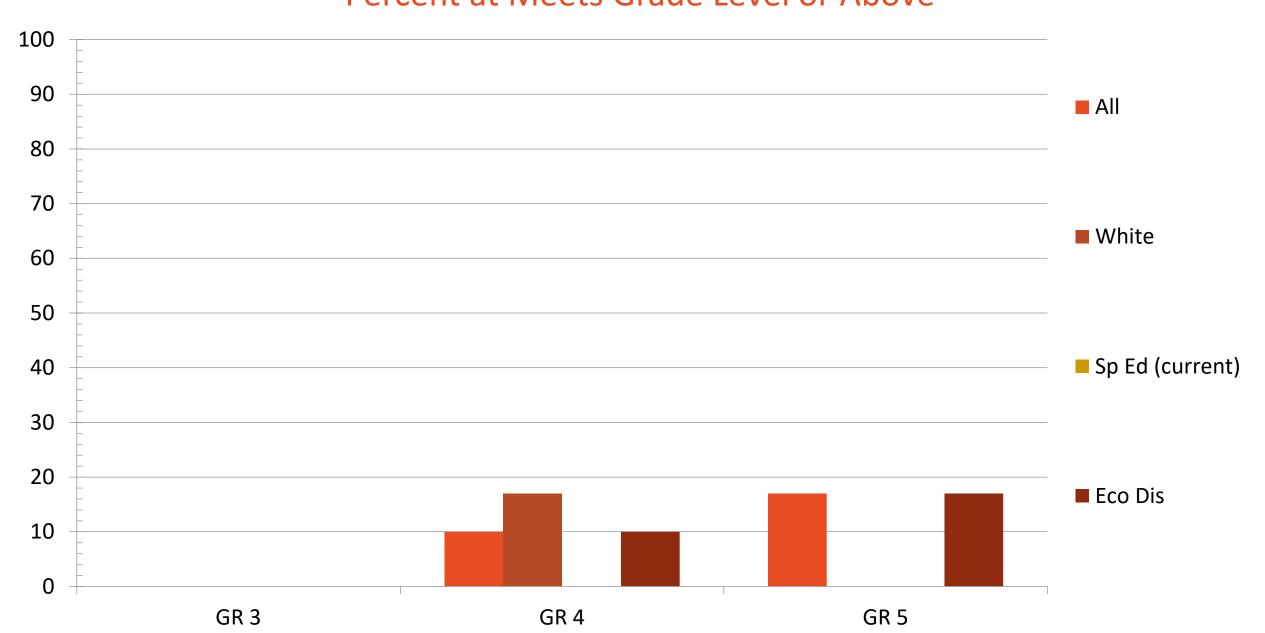
2024 STAAR 3-8 Math Performance Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above



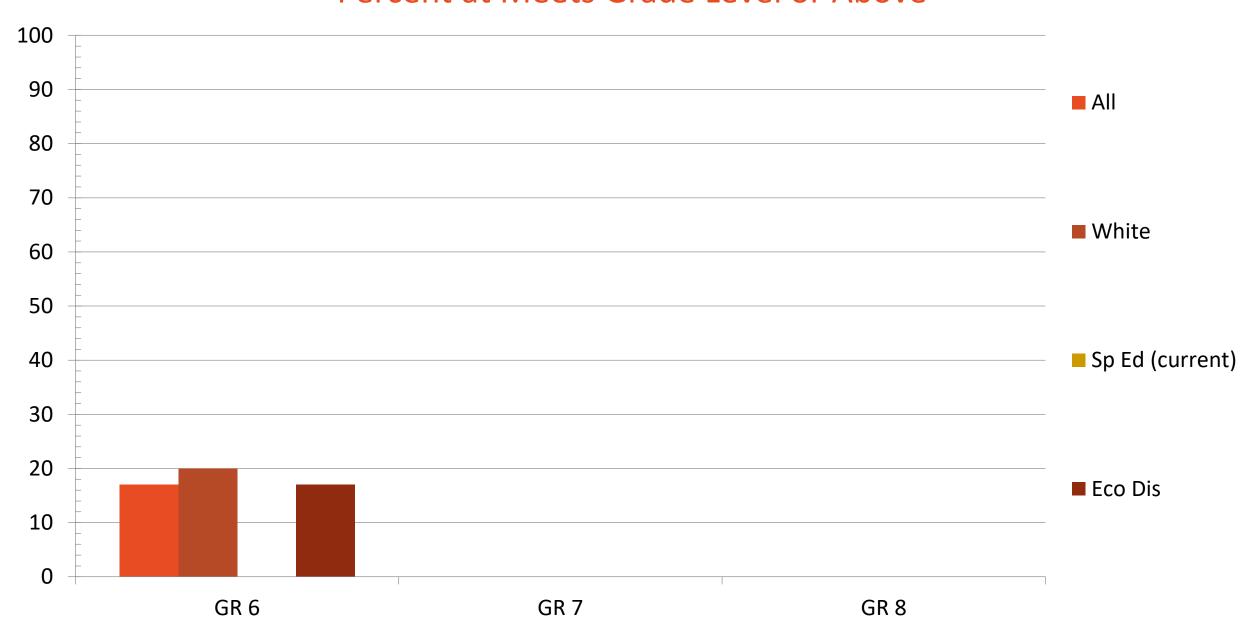

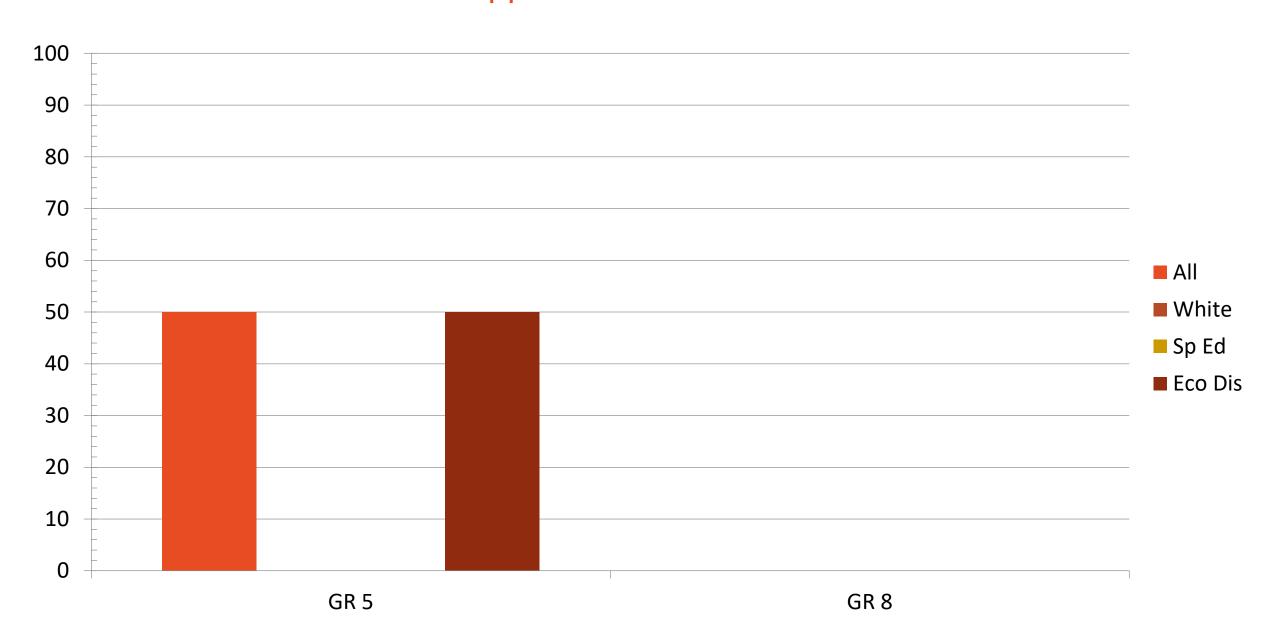

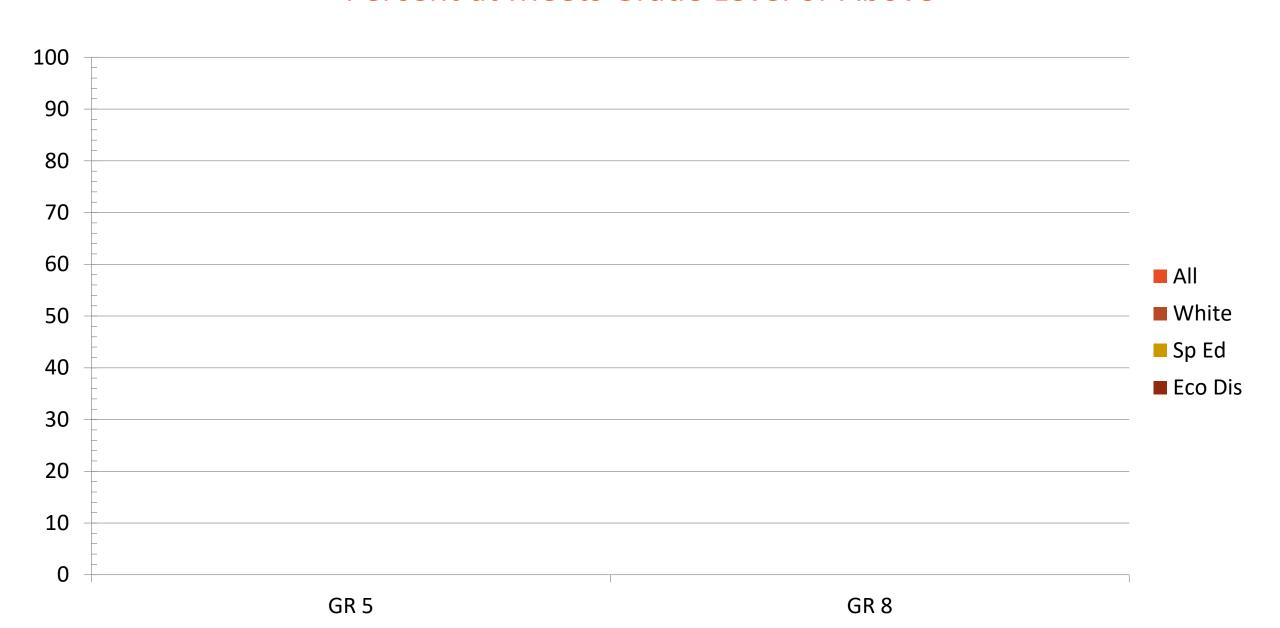

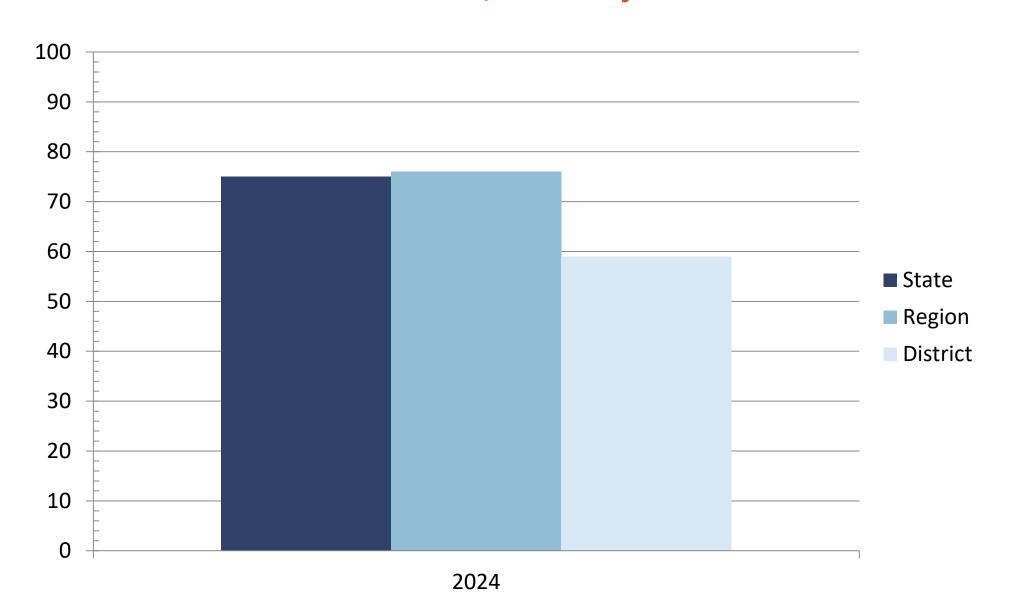

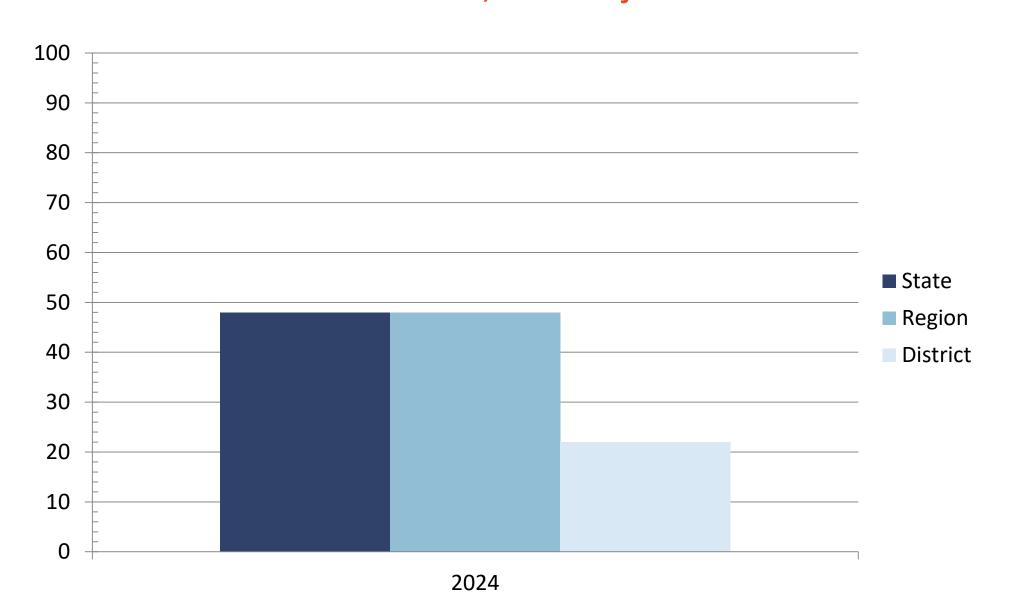

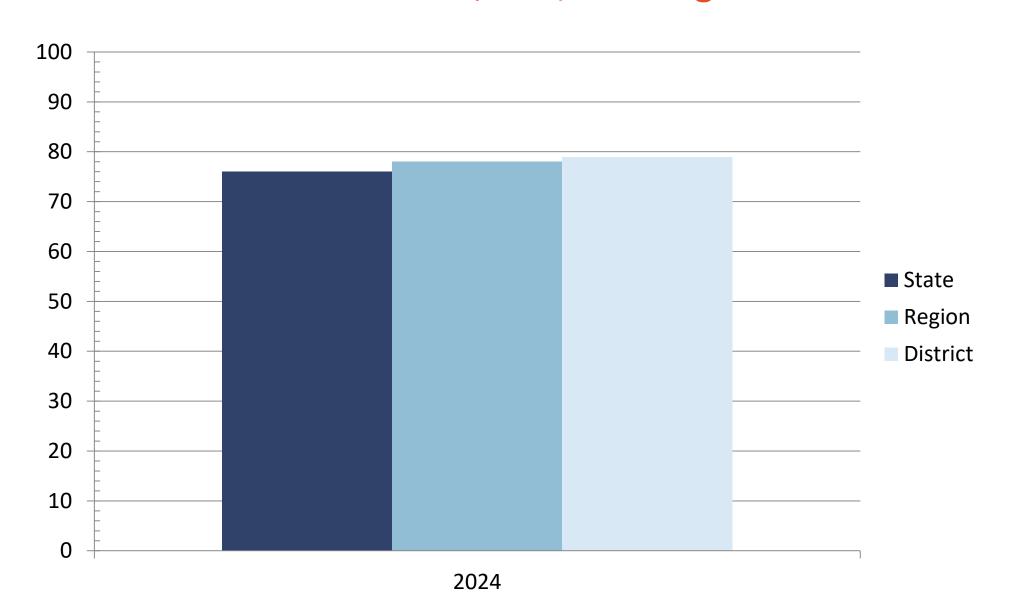

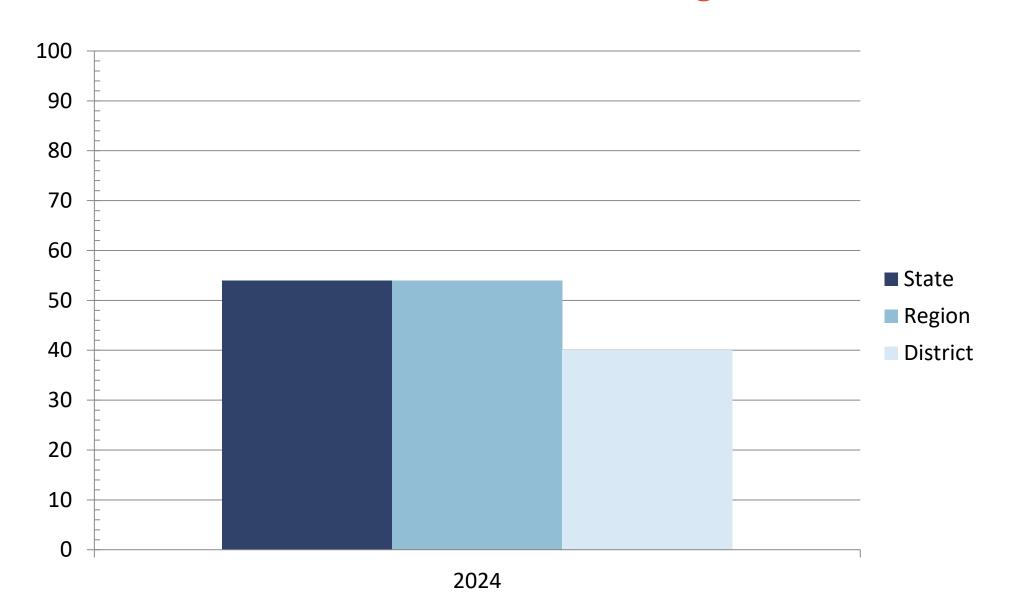

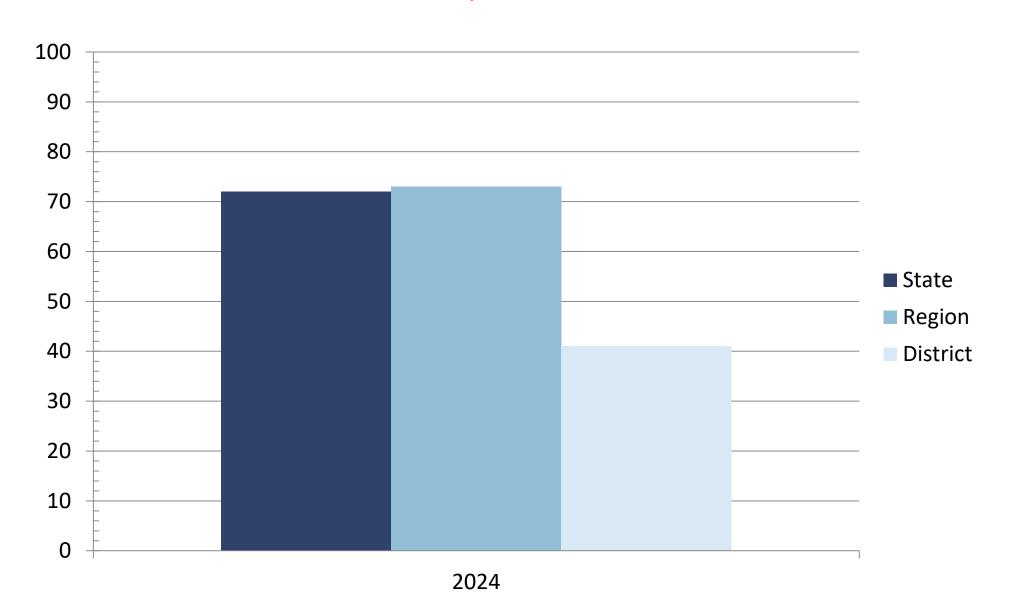
STAAR Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above All Grades, ELA/Reading



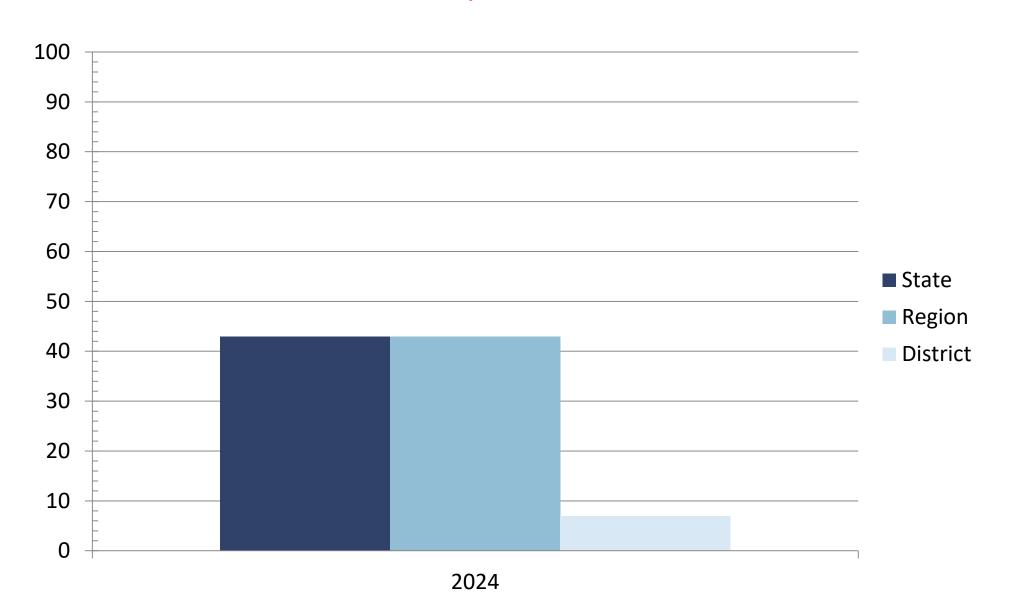

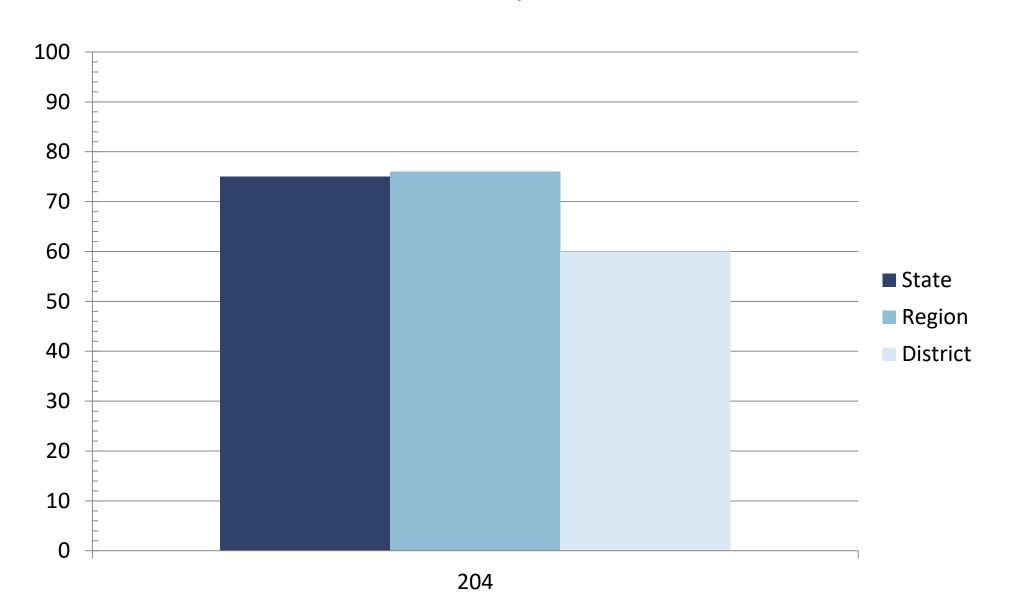

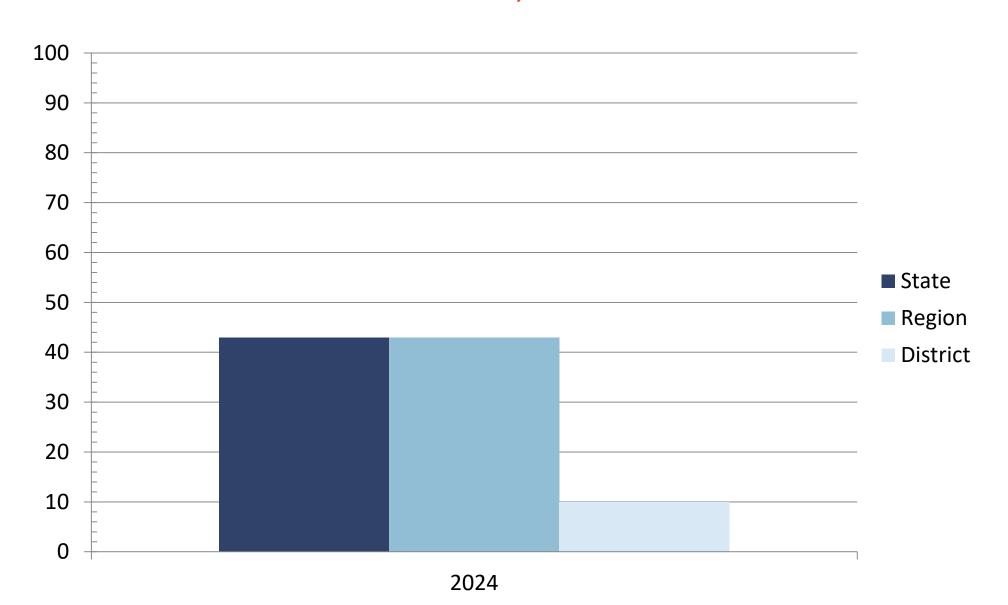

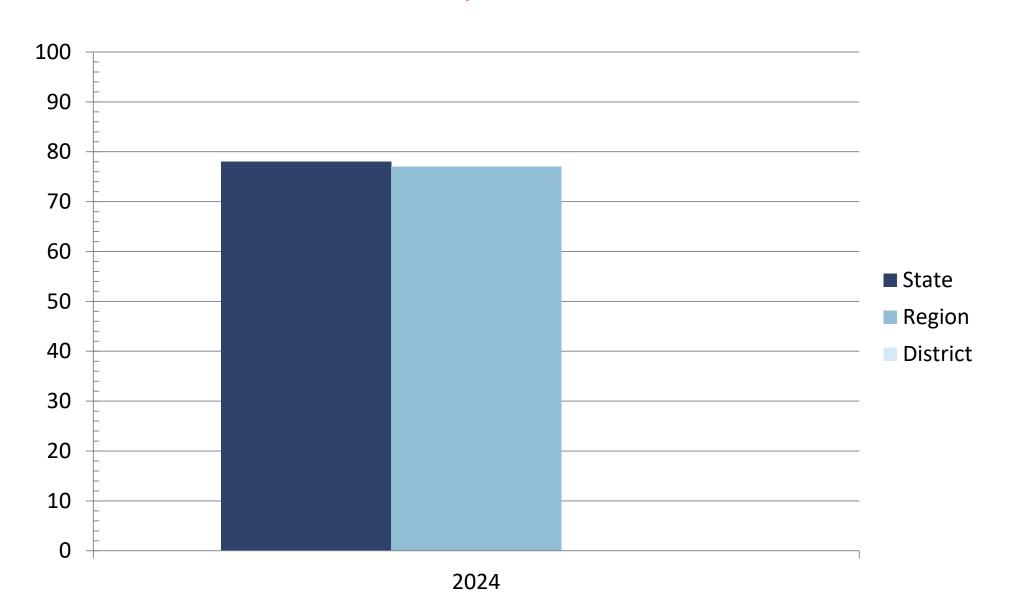

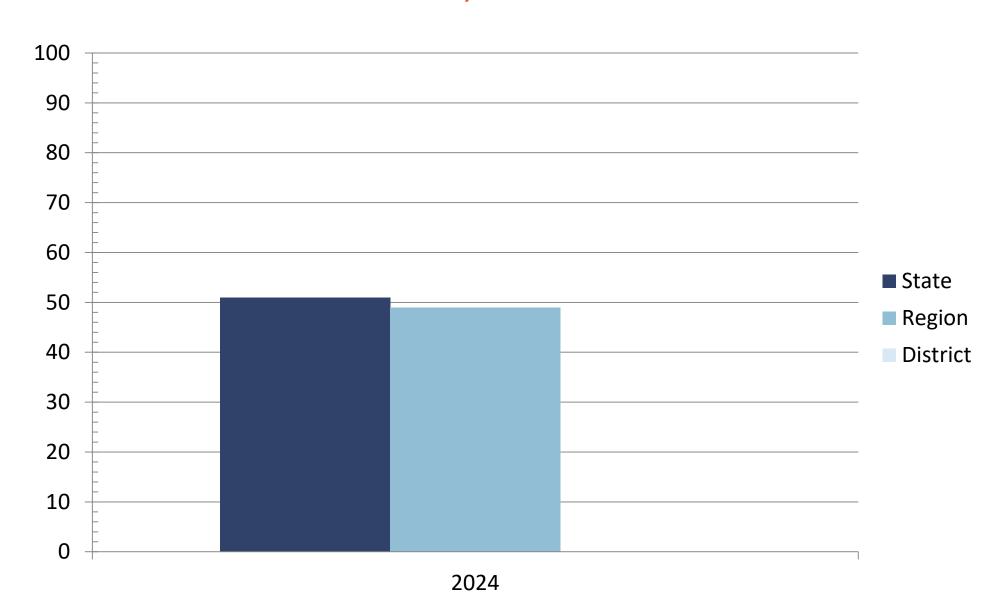

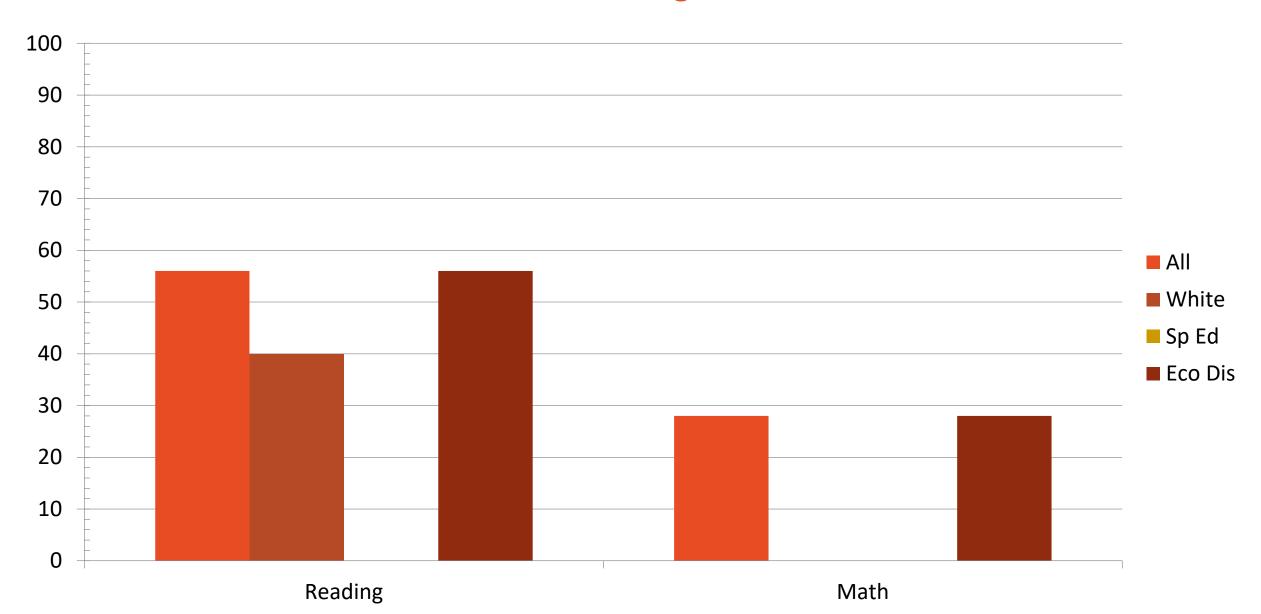

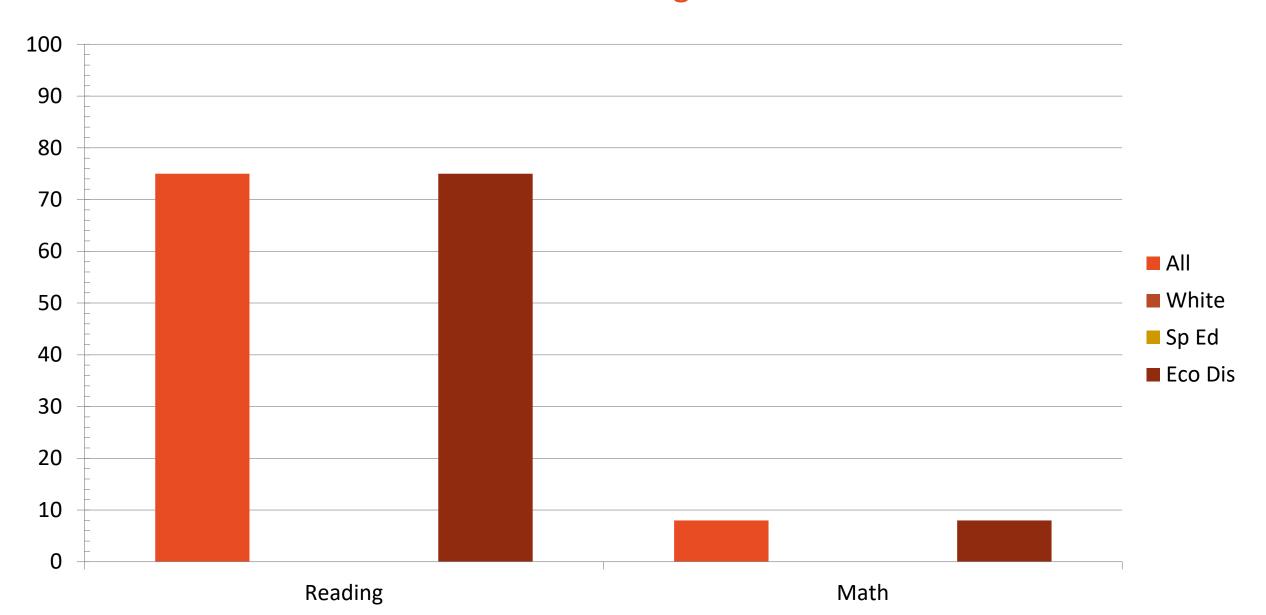

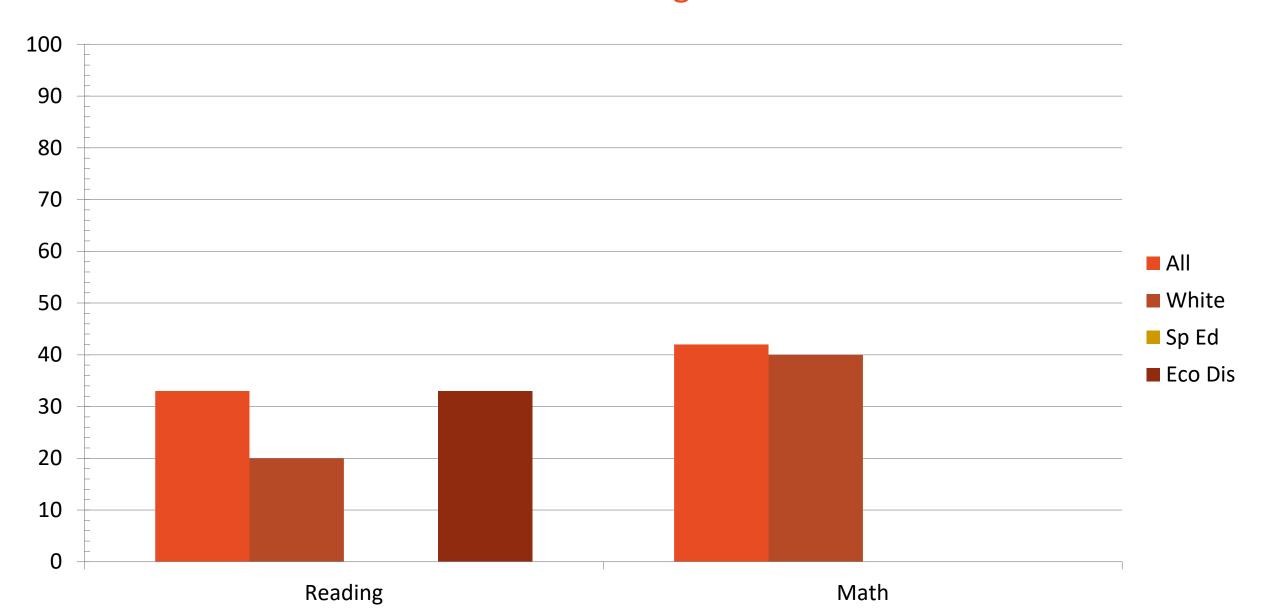
2024 Academic Growth Score 4th Grade Reading and Math



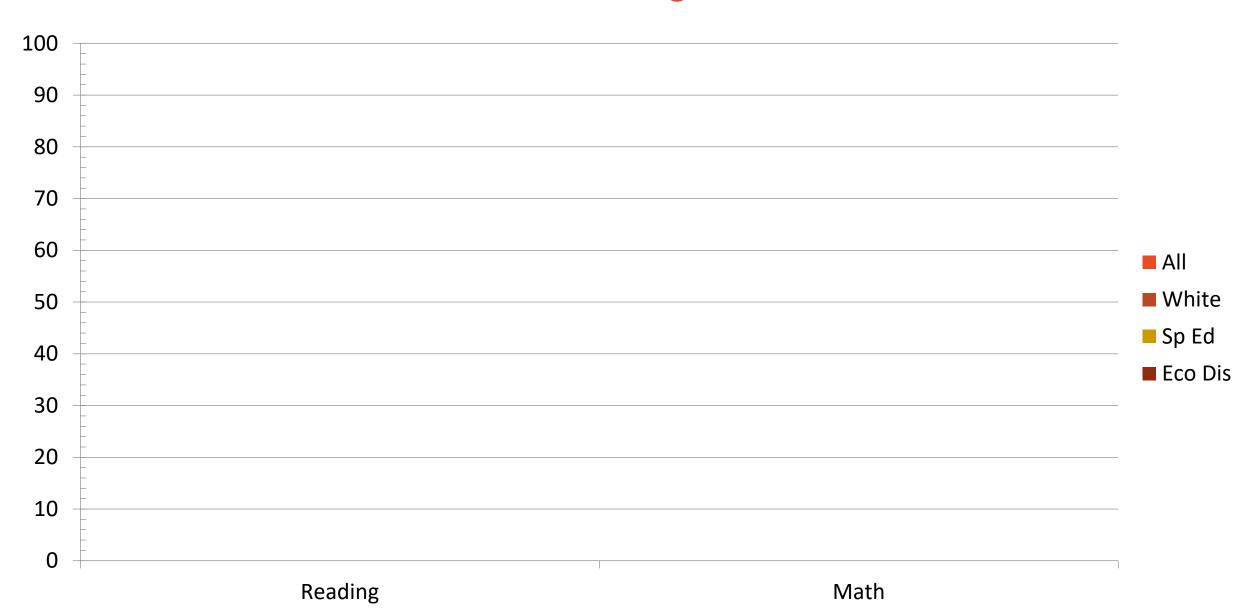
2024 Academic Growth Score 5th Grade Reading and Math

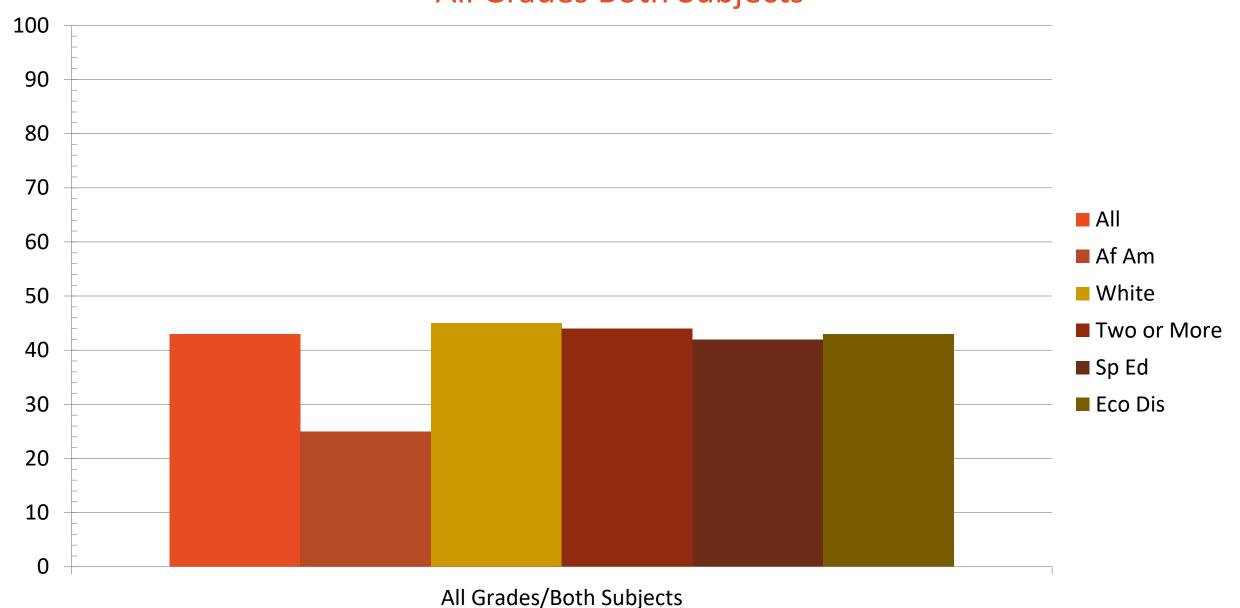

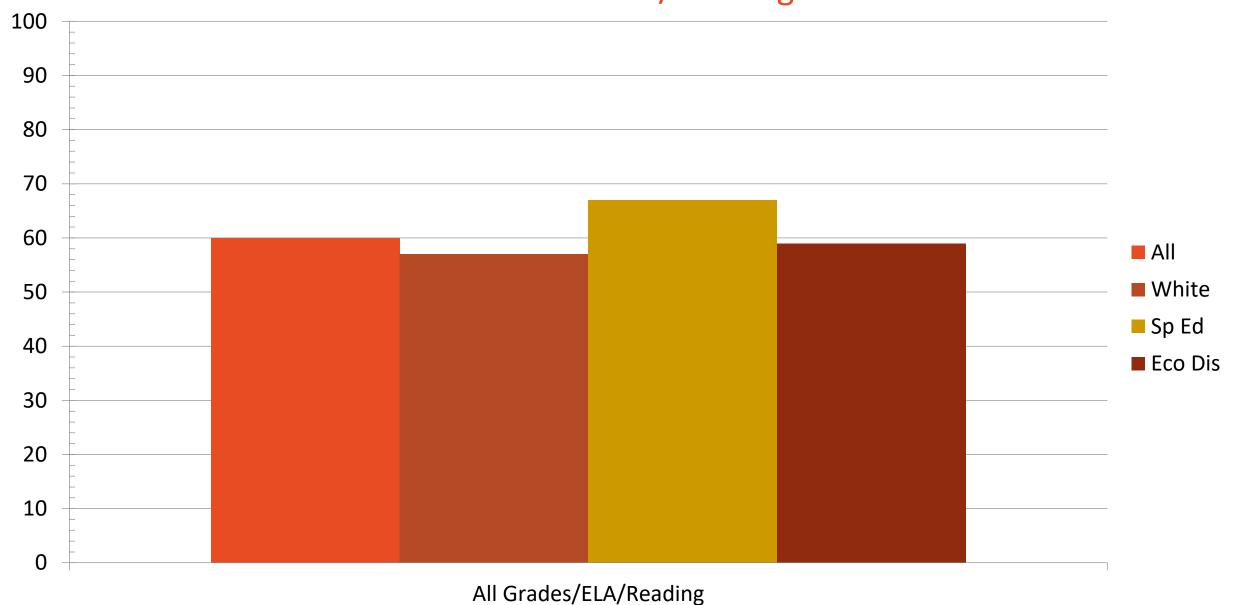

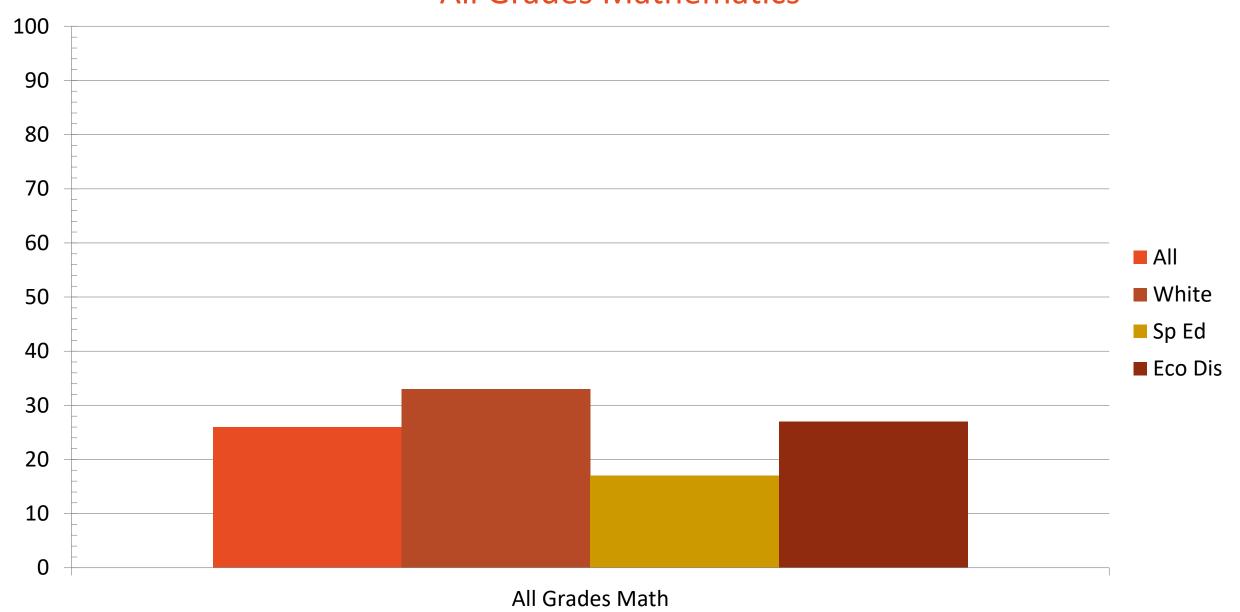
2024 Academic Growth Score All Grades Both Subjects

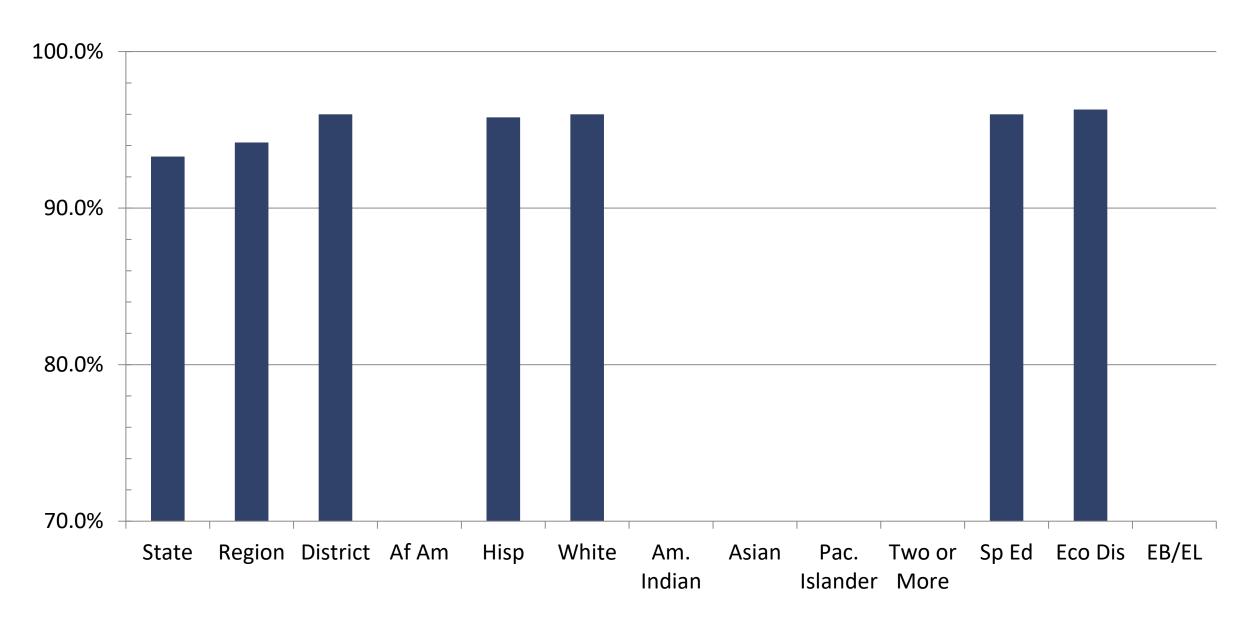


2024 Academic Growth Score All Grades Mathematics



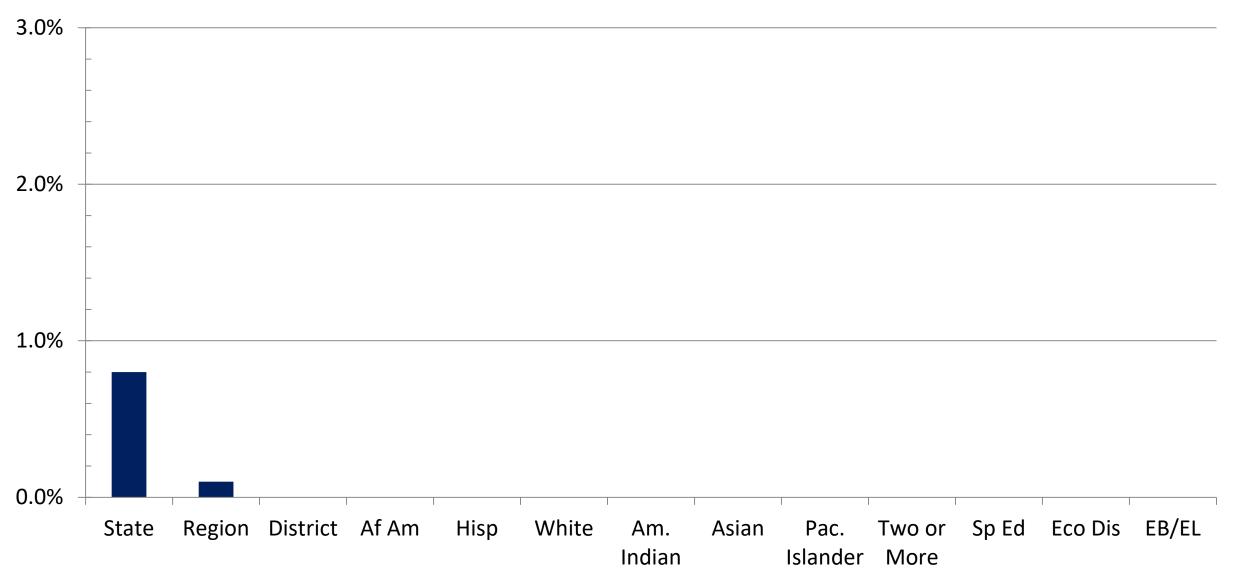

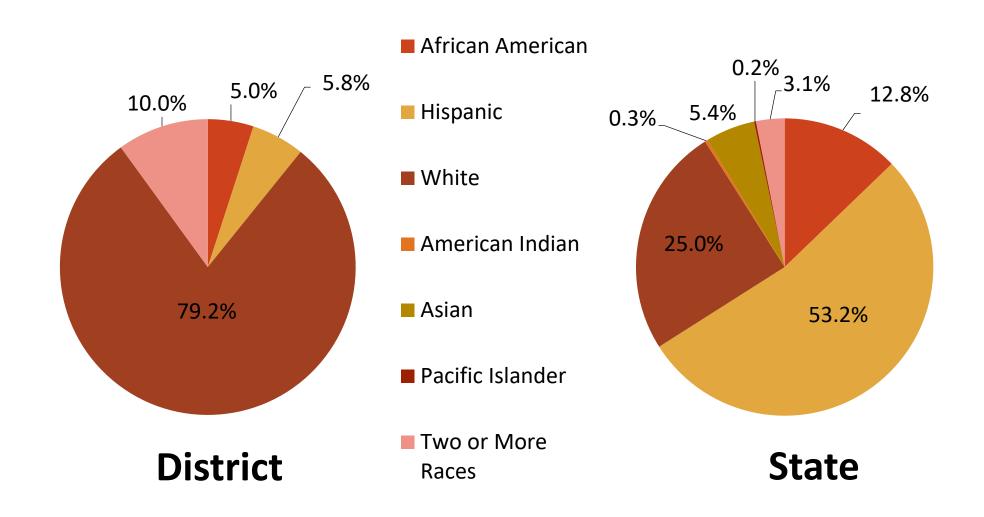


2024 Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 7-8)

2023 – 2024 Student Ethnic Distribution



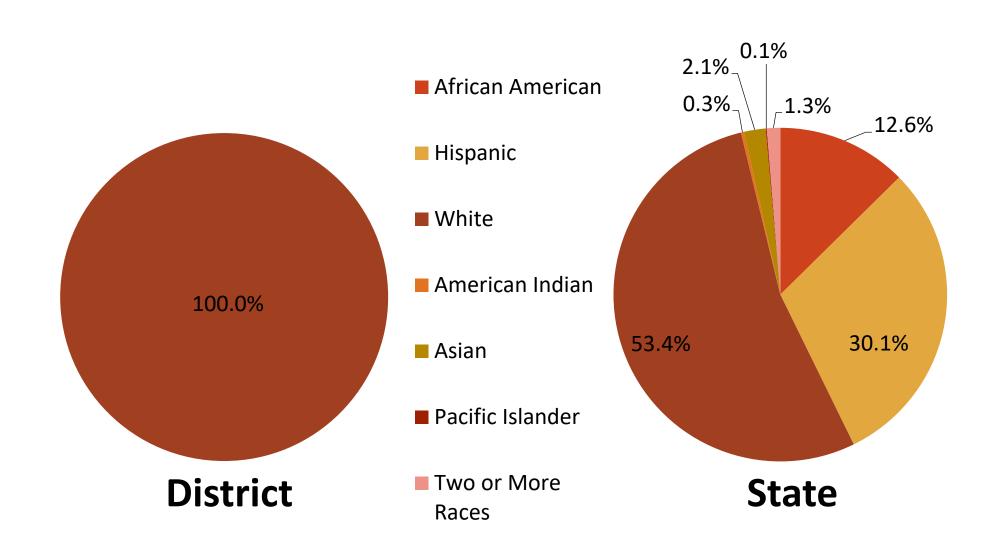

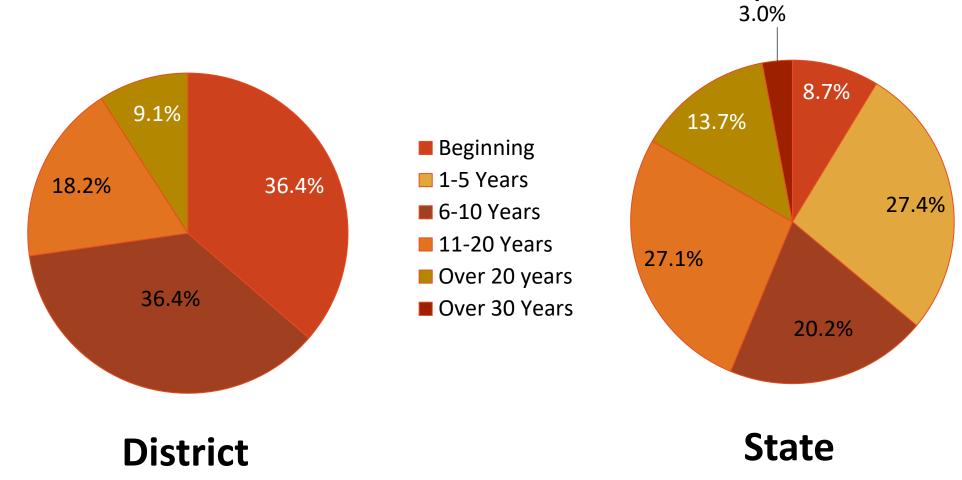

In order to prevent school violence and to protect students at Leary ISD, we have policies and procedures in place. We provide supervision of students in transition times, on the playground, and in the cafeteria as well as in the classrooms. We follow our student code of conduct, teaching students who are involved in misbehavior more appropriate behaviors as well as issuing consequences as stated in the code of conduct.

Leary ISD provides staff development sessions on topics including positive behavior support; sexual harassment, teen dating violence; identifying and reporting child abuse and neglect; suicide prevention; and identifying and meeting individual needs of students.
