

JGH School Food Service Programs

The district will provide a school food service program. Food service rules shall be published in student handbooks. Building Principals shall develop individual building rules.

Free or Reduced Price Meals

Free or reduced price meals shall be provided for students who qualify under state and federal rules and regulations.

The eligibility forms, rules and regulations governing this program shall be provided by the administration to students or their parents.

National School Breakfast Program – Alternative Program

Renwick schools do not participate in the National School Breakfast Program and therefore do not regularly serve or offer a breakfast for district students prior to the beginning of the school day. We do offer an alternative program at no charge to students or parents.

Each school maintains shelf stable items that can be served to students. Any student in need of nourishment, not enrolled in the before school YMCA program, may be provided these foods, at no cost to the family.

The district staff is informed of the program by building principals at the start of each school year. They are responsible for identifying children in need of the morning nourishment, ensuring they have access to such food items and recording the name, date and number of students requiring the alternative nourishment. Each month the list is sent to the Food Service office and kept on file. Parents are informed of this program at enrollment in the food service information packet that is provided to all households upon enrolling their student(s). District health staff or school office staff will administer the program at the building level and keep records as necessary.
