Reminder About Medication

Prescription and over-the-counter medications will be given at school only with a written note from your doctor. 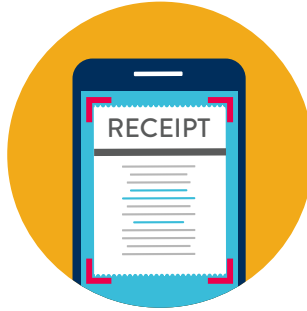
