This week they have followed the writing process on a small scale as they have published a sentence. The steps of the writing process are Prewriting, Drafting, Revising, Editing, and Publishing. The class will continue to build on this method as they create fiction and non-fiction pieces. Reading and writing go hand-inhand. You must read to build your vocabulary and learn the sentence structure of our language. Fourth grade is the first encounter students have with the STAAR writing test, and Mrs. Green makes sure that her students all know the writing process and are getting in plenty of reading.
