We ask that you refrain from placing blame on a player or coach by pointing them out by name and that you not use foul language at all during our events. This will not be tolerated at all. Your conduct, whether you know or not, allow these young people to have pride in their school and community. While your sportsmanlike actions may play a small part in the outcome of a game, it will play a great role in continuing to encourage our students and our competitive athletics.

You as fans should:

- 1) Should not criticize the players on either team.
- 2) Should not boo the officials
- 3) Should not have alcoholic beverages or tobacco products on public school grounds since it is a violation of state law
- 4) Should not boo, talk bad about, or use foul language directed toward your team or coaches
- 5) Should show respect for injured players on both teams.

We have the right to remove you from the stadium or gym if you violate these rules.

If you are escorted out of the stadium or gym due to any unsportsmanlike activities, you will not be allowed back for the remainder of the year. Please think about your actions and how you are role models for the kids!!!
