Recommended Graduation Requirements as Adopted by Richards ISD Board of Trustees

Foundation High School Program – 22 Credits (must have approval to graduate under this plan)*indicates district requirement

English – 4 credits

Science – 3 credits

Math – 3 credits

Social Studies – 3 credits

P.E. – 1 credit

Fine Arts – 1 credit

Foreign Language – 2 credits

Speech – ½ credit*

Health – ½ credit*

Electives – 4 credits



Foundation Program with Endorsements – 26+ Credits and completion of the Foundation High School Program. (Each endorsement area requires completion of two advanced courses taken from a coherent sequence. All students will, at least, be working towards some form of the Multidisciplinary Endorsement.)



Business & Industry

- 4 coherent sequence credits in a single area
- AFNR (Ag), MNF (Manuf), BMA (Bus Mgt), or IT (Info Tech)



Arts & Humanities

- 4 credits from Art or Foreign Language
- 5 credits in Social Studies or English



Multidisciplinary

- Select 2 courses from 2 different endorsement areas or four from one area not in a coherent sequence
- Take 8 semester dual credit courses (4 high school credits)
- 4x4 core academic credits w/ EnglishVI, AlgebraII, Chemistry & Physics



STEM

- 5 credits
- Math or Science
