SENIORS: Be Aware of priority deadlines for direct 4 yr college admissions and their scholarship applications. Some are as early as Oct 15!! The sooner you apply, the better financial aid package you may receive. FAFSA opens up OCT 1st. If you or your parents need assistance, I'm here to help.

Voice of Democracy Scholarship Competition - * 9 to 12th *** - between \$1000 and \$30,000**

Deadline: Oct 31

submit a 3-5 minute recorded essay on this year's theme; "Why My Vote Matters" to local VFW

Zombie Apocalypse Scholarship - * 13+ yrs old *** - \$2000**

Deadline: Oct 31

Enroll into vocational/2 or 4 yr college by Fall 2024, committee wants to know your plan to avoid the zombies, where you'd hide, and the top-five things you'd bring to stay alive in 250 words or less

P.E.O. Star Scholarship - * female seniors *** - \$2500**

Deadline: Nov 1

3.0/4.0 gpa, transcript, letters of recommendation, extracurricular activities, leadership, community service, interview, etc. You will need to request a sponsoring chapter via email and authorization for an application.

Ron Brown Scholar Program - 20+ up to \$10,000/yr

Deadline: Nov 1 for early consideration, Jan 9 for absolute deadline

African-American descent, academics, transcript, SAT/ACT scores (take test no later than Nov for the Jan 9 deadline), essay response to one of two prompts, letters of recommendation, leadership, activities, financial need, etc.

National Center for Women & Information Technology Award for Aspirations in Computing - * 9 to 12th female *** - varies**

Deadline: Nov 5

demonstrated interest and achievements in computing, proven leadership ability, academic performance, recommendations, etc

Hagan Scholarship Foundation - up to \$6000/semester

Deadline: Nov 15

Must be a graduating from a high school in a rural area (that's us!), 3.5/4.0 gpa, demonstrate financial need (FAFSA), SAT 1200+/or ACT 23+, work 240 hours between Aug 2018 and Aug 2019, attend a 4 yr college
