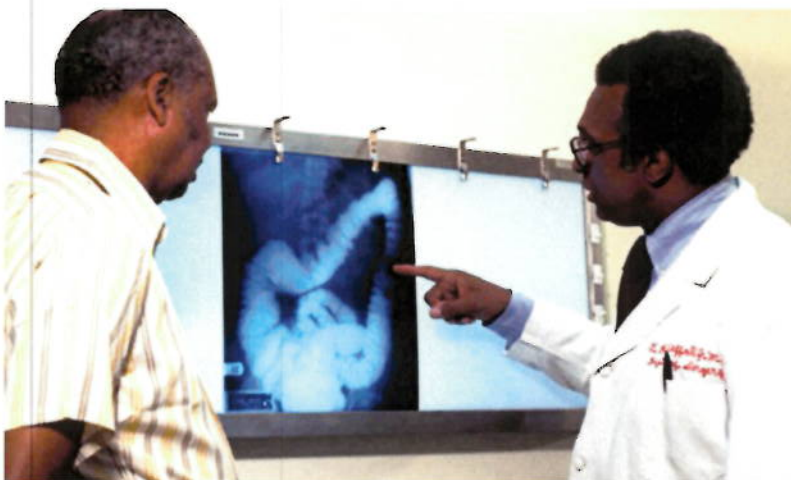

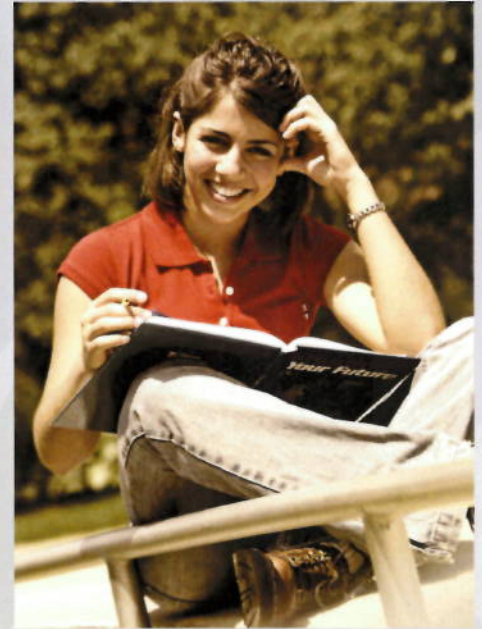
People age 50 or older should get regular screenings to reduce their risk of colorectal cancer.
