  - Aligns with goals of the Fund (funds will be used for the benefit of the school, students, and teachers)
  - Impact on students
  - Meets grant guideline, (does not exceed funds available, submitted on time, in correct format, with signatures etc.)
  - Teachers may submit **one** grant proposal for this funding cycle.
  - Follow directions as specified
  - Spell out acronyms
  - Check your proposal for correct grammar and spelling
  - Grants to be "self contained", not add on funds to other resources
  - Follow up information to the Fund is required. Photos and documentation for publicity purposes and verification of grant usage are required.
