Details:

- Funds are available for grants. Amounts and number of grants awarded continue to grow. The larger the grant, the more students would need to benefit and/or have a greater impact for the school and students. **No amount requested is too small.** A lower requested amount may be seen as providing the most benefit.
- Applications available on the school website
- Applications due Friday, November 5th, 2021
- Selection and funds available early November, before Thanksgiving break
- Grant Criteria
 - Demonstrates Innovation or Essential Classroom Need
 - Aligns with goals of the Fund (funds will be used for the benefit of the school, students, and teachers)
 - Impact on students
 - Meets grant guideline, (does not exceed funds available, submitted on time, in correct format, with signatures etc.)
 - Teachers may submit **one** grant proposal for this funding cycle.
 - Follow directions as specified
 - Spell out acronyms
 - Check your proposal for correct grammar and spelling
 - Teacher grants may be submitted from two or more teachers/areas of instruction. Grants may also be part of a partnership, i.e. with school monies or in kind donations, or an outside resource such as a local business. Documentation of such partnerships must be included with the application.
 - Building grant applications may include other resources such as in-kind donations, labor, tech support etc. that the school may provide. Outside resources may also be considered. Documentation of these resources must be included with the grant application.
 - Follow up information to the Fund is required. *Photos and documentation for publicity purposes and verification of grant usage are required.*
 - **Include purchase price/vendor information-attach to application/scan**
