

Prom is a formal event. Only formal attire will be allowed.

(NO blue jeans, overalls, t-shirts, baseball caps/visors, tennis shoes, Converse shoes, tattoos showing, or sunglasses.)

GIRLS

- 1. No excessively low or plunging necklines in the front.
- 2. Backless dresses are acceptable as long as it does not dip below the small of the back.
- 3. No cut-outs in the mid-section will be allowed.
- 4. Side, front, and back slits need to be no higher than halfway between the knee and upper thigh.
- 5. Skirts can be worn with the waistband no more than 1 inch below the navel with no exposed mid-section.
- 6. Strapless dresses are acceptable as long as they adhere to all of the above.
- 7. Earrings will be the only acceptable body piercings allowed.
- 8. Dress length must not be excessively short.
- 9. Body art of any form is prohibited and must be covered.

GUYS

- 1. Facial hair is permitted on high school students as long as it remains neat and trimmed to allow a length no longer than one-quarter (1/4) inch.
- 2. Hair length for male students shall not extend below the collar.
- 3. Hair must be a natural color. No extreme hairstyles or shaven design type cuts.
- 4. All guys must be in a tuxedo or a suit.
- 5. Starched **BLACK** jeans will be allowed with a tuxedo jacket. (NO blue jeans or faded black jeans.)
- 6. Dress hats are acceptable. (Top hats, cowboy hats)
- 7. Stud earrings will be the only acceptable body piercings allowed.
- 8. Body art of any form is prohibited and must be covered.

** If you question whether your attire will be acceptable at prom, bring a picture or description of the garment to Mrs. Sanders in C221 before you purchase it. If you **DO NOT** comply with the dress code you will be asked to leave and will not receive a refund. **

No guest over the age of 20 will be allowed into Prom.
