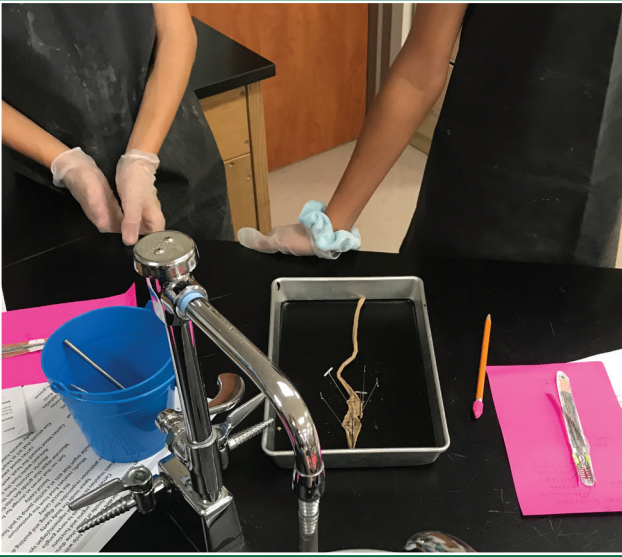
7th-graders share their thoughts about the lab...
