It is a joint effort between the Army and LHS to produce successful students and citizens while encouraging a more constructive and disciplined learning environment. With the school's support, the JROTC program achieves these outcomes by using a technology driven, student centered curriculum. The curriculum consists of education in citizenship, leadership, social and communication skills, physical fitness and wellness, geography, and civics.

The curriculum is facilitated and taught by retired Army personnel. Qualified retired Army personnel are employed by the schools to teach the JROTC curriculum. JROTC teacher qualifications are based on military experience, maturity, stability, and leadership acquired over 20 years of service to our nation. To safeguard the viability of the JROTC program, the Department of Defense (DoD) and the Department of Education endorse the proposition that states recognize that JROTC instructors are certified to teach JROTC and the range of subject areas included in the program such as Physical Education, Health/Wellness, Civics, and more.

JROTC mission is to motivate young people to be better citizens. It is a successful program, making substantial contributions to students, schools, and communities which benefit greatly from its presence.


