

**Jennings Public Schools  
Daily COVID-19 School Attendance Questionnaire  
2021-2022**

In an effort to prevent possible exposure of staff and students to COVID-19, you are requested to review the following questions each morning and PRIOR to your child riding a school bus or entering school. In addition, this questionnaire will be utilized to screen any adults entering the building.

- Does your child have any of the following symptoms of COVID-19? (Class A Symptoms)
  - Fever  $\geq 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$
  - Sore Throat
  - Cough
  - Difficulty Breathing
  - Diarrhea or Vomiting
  - New Loss of Taste or Smell
  
- Is your child experiencing three or more of the following symptoms of COVID-19? (Class B Symptoms)
  - Stuffy Nose
  - Runny nose
  - Muscle/Body Aches
  - Fatigue
  - Chills
  - Nausea
  - Loss of Appetite
  - Elevated Temperature  $< 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$
  - New Onset of Severe Headache
  
- Has your child tested positive for COVID-19 or do you think your child may have COVID-19?

If the answer to any of these questions is "YES," **YOUR CHILD SHOULD REMAIN AT HOME** and you should contact Mrs. Jeanette by phone or email by 9:00 AM (918-757-2536 or [jskinner@jennings.k12.ok.us](mailto:jskinner@jennings.k12.ok.us)). Students remaining home because of COVID-19 concerns will automatically move to our blended learning protocol.

If your answer to any of the questions is "YES," please contact your physician or schedule COVID-19 testing. The Pawnee County Health Department and all area Wal-Greens do onsite COVID-19 testing.

You may also COVID-19 Call Center at 2-1-1 for specific guidance on the criteria to be met before your child returns to school.
