BEFORE SCHOOL

7:20-7:45

Increased Security

Rains ISD is making big improvements in campus security throughout the district.

Thanks to our school board and community for supporting increased measures that keep our students and staff safe.

Here are the new additions to district/campus security:

- RISD now employs 2 fulltime police officers (SRO's).
- 2. Buzzers were installed at each campus this summer at office doors. To enter the Intermediate office, visitors must be buzzed in. To enter the hallway, visitors must also be buzzed in.
- Cameras were installed in all campus hallways and at doors.
- 4. Classroom doors stay locked all day.



- 5. The district has become a part of the School Guardian program, which trains select staff for 80 hours and certifies them to conceal & carry a handgun. The staff are anonymous and are only known to a select few, such as the school board. Staff would only ever use their training in the event of a crisis such as an active shooter on campus.
- DPS has contracted with Rains ISD to move their office to the former Head Start building, across from the Intermediate.

Student safety is a priority at Rains ISD.
