

TRANSFERS FROM NONACCREDITED SCHOOLS

Students transferring into The Tonkawa School District from a school not accredited by the Oklahoma State Department of Education, or enrolling in the school district immediately after being a home-schooled student, shall be required to take comprehensive written examinations in the subjects studied or grades attended in the nonaccredited school. Results of the examinations will be utilized in determining the academic units or grade levels for which a student is to receive credit. In order for a student to enroll in courses that have prerequisites, the student must have passed the proficiency exam for that prerequisite. Proficiency must be demonstrated by exam on all courses required for graduation from Tonkawa High School.

Exams will be given only for courses offered at Tonkawa High School and Tonkawa Junior High School. Tonkawa Public School District shall administer all examinations. Copies of the exams and the results thereof shall be placed in the student's file.
