

## STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The Tonkawa Board of Education supports the belief that the result of one's behavior will be a consequence--positive or negative in nature. Therefore, for the ultimate benefit of the student, rules of student discipline must be set and followed by the school district.

All students of The Tonkawa School District are subject to these discipline policies while on school grounds, being transported to and from school or school functions by district transportation, and while participating in functions sponsored by the district.

The individual teacher in compliance with board policy will most likely determine methods of discipline. Discipline to be considered will always provide options for the types of discipline.

The board believes that parental support in areas of student discipline is particularly important. Therefore, the district shall make efforts to assist parents in developing skills and attitudes necessary in helping their children succeed in school and shall allow appropriate involvement of parents, students and staff in developing student discipline policies.

All students, teachers and parents or guardians shall be notified of this policy and will be provided a copy upon request.
