Dear WISD parents and guardians,

A Wortham High School student has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy requirements, we will not be releasing the name of the individual or identifying details. The student was last on campus today, August 19th.

We have contacted the local health department to report the positive case, and we will work with the health department to identify any exposures. Through conversations with the families, we have identified and contacted those individuals who were with the student during the possible infectious period. The Texas Department of State Health Services may further identify and contact other close contacts and make quarantine recommendations.

While we do not believe that those who were in contact with the infected individual have reason to be concerned, we ask that you, as always, watch for symptoms of COVID-19:

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth;
- Sore throat;
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing;
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain;
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

If any member of our WISD community does begin experiencing any of these symptoms in a way that is not typical, we encourage you to contact your physician.
