**Agenda Items**

1. The minutes for the previous meeting on October 25, 2017 were read and approved.
2. Melanie Brown presented the cafeteria services update.
  - Meal Viewer Card – advertises a downloadable app with nutrition information
  - Digital signage will be used in the cafeteria next year.
  - Taste test days were a success this year.
  - Gluten free bread will be available next year.
  - The Summer Feed Program will run June 4-August 3 except for the week of July 4. Breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack will be available Monday-Friday.
  - The audit by the Texas Department of Agriculture went well.
3. Amanda Ford present the health services update.
  - The audit by the Department of State Health Services on November 16, 2017 went very well. VVISD received a score of 99%, with the only deduction being due to an incorrectly notarized form.
  - Immunization letters will be mailed out to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders to make sure parents are aware of state mandates
  - The Valley View Family Medical Clinic and the Texas Department of Health will conduct an immunization clinic in August. This will be advertised in the immunization letter and on the school website and Facebook page.
  - Elementary students enjoyed dental education programs sponsored by the Masonic Lodge and Gage Dental during February.
  - Vision, hearing, and spinal screenings have been completed. Re-screenings are now taking place now.
  - Acanthosis Nigricans risk assessment (Type 2 Diabetes) was given.
  - A blood drive was held in October and another is scheduled for May 1. Graduating seniors who give blood can participate in the Red Cord Honors Program sponsored by Texoma Regional Blood Center.
4. Jesse Newton read the PE update that was prepared by Penny Green.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders Fitnessgram testing is nearly complete. Middle and High school students will complete it in May.
  - Little Eagle Relays is scheduled for May 11.
5. Jesse Newton and Hillary Terry gave the Educational Programs update.

- 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders enjoyed a presentation by the North Texas Poison Center about drug and poison prevention.
  - Abstinence education for the 7<sup>th</sup> graders will begin soon.
  - Mrs. Elles (MS Counselor) will be conducting a Human Growth and Development session with the 5<sup>th</sup> grade girls soon.
  - CPR instruction was given to the 8<sup>th</sup> graders and will be presented to the senior class in May.
  - A dental presentation for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders will be scheduled in May.
