Delta’s Scholarship Purpose:

This scholarship was organized by the Forrest City Chapter to ensure that students wanting to attend college would have extra help to pursue their educational aspirations.

What is the Amount of the Scholarship?

The recipient will be given a 500.00 scholarship, upon receipt of enrollment.

Who Can Apply?

Any high school senior that is planning to attend college in the fall may apply. The person may be a male or female. Student must have a 2.5 or above grade point average. An official transcript must be with a completed application.

How Do I Apply?

Students must turn in a completed application packet:

- **Completed Application form**
- **Official Transcript**
- **Two letters of Recommendation**
 - One letter should be from a teacher whom the student is presently enrolled.
 - A character letter- a community person (not relative)
- **One essay completed as follows:**
 - ✓ The Essay should be typed,
 - ✓ Minimum of 350 words
 - ✓ Double spaced
 - ✓ Use 12 pt font

Please turn this application and two letters of recommendation by April 15, 2021. If awarded, the scholarship will be in the amount of 500.00 dollars. **Application must be mailed into the chapter mailbox by due date to be considered.**
