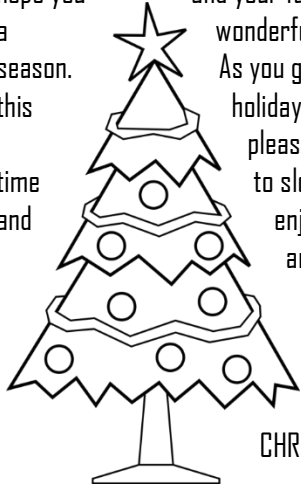


THE BLIMEY NOTES for DECEMBER...

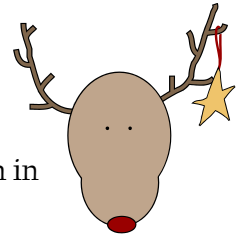
