
Re: Covid Protocols at Extracurricular Events

In light of the COVID status-Orange in LeFlore County, Bokoshe Public Schools will be adhering to the following protocols during any of our basketball games, academic meets, etc. held indoors on our campus:

1. Attendees will be required to take their temperatures at the door. Please remain at home if exhibiting symptoms such as fever or a cough.
2. Masks or face coverings will be required except when seated and stationary in the bleachers.
3. It will be asked that attendees social distance, singly or in family groups.
4. Attendees will be asked to wear a mask any time a trip is made down to the lobby, concession stand, or restroom.
5. Players, coaches, referees, scorekeepers, and stat keepers will be the only ones allowed on the floor in the gym during basketball games.

We realize that everyone has their own opinion of the policies we have seen implemented and have experienced frustration at the way our lives have been turned around in the past year. Still, let's remember that some of us have been extremely fortunate in maintaining our health while others, with varying health and age related issues have not. In the school setting, at an extra-curricular event, please remember that there will be many attendees coming from many different environments.
