Scholarship Guidelines

To qualify, you must be a current DMS 8th Grade band student, and enrolled in band at the high school level. Must have at least a 3.0 GPA, which will be verified through the administrators at DMS.

This scholarship application along with an essay of what band/music means to you and one letter of recommendation must be returned to Mr. Dickson or Mr. Gregg, no later than Friday May 4, 2018.

The review committee, which may consists of any of the following; Bryan & Lisa Hallmark, DHS Band Booster Club President, Band Director Mr. Gregg, Administrator from DMS, and a Lions Club representative will meet and review the applications. Two scholarship winners will be selected from the applications and the winners will be announced at the DMS awards ceremony in May. The winners will be presented a plaque.

Each of the two scholarships are worth \$250. The scholarship money will be placed into the students band account, and is for the student's band fees expenses the student will incur during their freshman year in band. This account is managed by the band director Mr. Gregg.

This scholarship is funded by generous donations from the Durant Lions Club and by the Cassie Hallmark Scholarship Memorial Fund.
