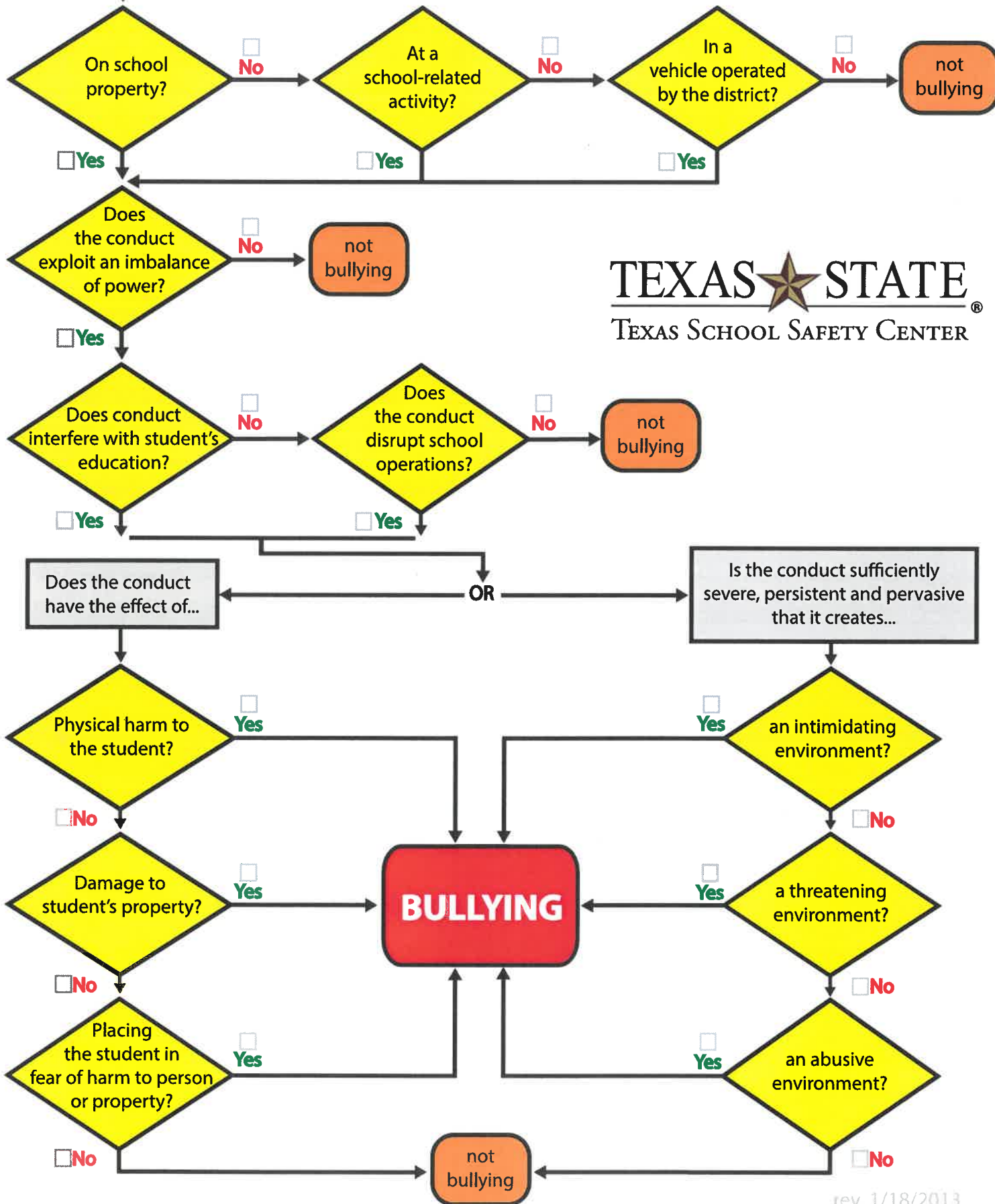


Does the conduct occur...

Use this flowchart to help determine whether WRITTEN, VERBAL, ELECTRONIC, or PHYSICAL conduct can be considered bullying according to **Texas Education Code, Section 37.0832**

1. Bullies target their victims: Those who bully are not aggressive to everyone. Instead, they seek an easy target that is easy to control physically and/or emotionally.

2. Bullying is not an accident; it is on purpose: The act of bullying is not an accident. While the aggressor may not consciously know why they are going after that particular target, their actions are willful and intentional.

3. Bullying is a constant, repeated problem: These negative interactions occur every day or on a regular basis. Sometimes the bully and victim do not see each other daily, but there is a pattern of repetition. Consider schedules during your investigation.

4. Bullying involves an Imbalance of Power: This IOP may be real or perceived. It may involve size and strength, but also include social status, academic abilities, talents, popularity, personality traits, or any quality both parties consider important.

5. Involves unwanted aggression and is meant to do harm: The "aggression" is not part of a game neither is it joking around between friends. Neither is it a response to constant badgering by the alleged "victim." It is an unprovoked negative interaction.
