A. Policy Involvement

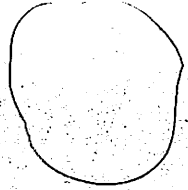
Forgan Schools are school wide Title I:

- Convene an annual meeting each year at Orientation, meeting with participating parents to inform them of Forgan Schools' participation in the School wide program and how Title I services will be provided to the students.
- In addition to the annual meeting, parents will have other opportunities throughout the year to provide feedback on the services provided to their children. This could be done by, but not limited to:
 - a. Informing parents when a student is recommended for a Reading Sufficiency Plan.
 - b. Morning, afternoon, or evening meetings
 - c. Quarterly report cards
 - d. E-mail
 - e. Student Information Systems
 - f. Written communication
 - g. Phone calls
 - h. Forgan School Handbook (online)
 - i. Parent survey feedback (yearly)
- Forgan Public Schools' Title I policy offers the following to its families:
 - a. Title One Parent Brochure at Orientation outlining the goals of the Title One Parent Program
 - b. Parent/Child Reading Literacy night
 - c. Parent Education Forum each year
 - d. End of Year Celebration for all students to be individually recognized for their participation in the program.

B. Shared Responsibility for High Student Academic Achievement

C. Building Capacity for Parent Involvement

To ensure the effective involvement of parents, to support a partnership between the Forgan School Community and the parent community, and to improve student academic achievement, our school staff shall:

- Provide assistance to the parents of our students to gain an understanding of the curriculum in all areas, and local assessments. This shall be done by, but not limited to:
 - An Annual School Report Night. This will be held in early fall after the State releases its annual Report Card.
 - The ELL & Title I Teachers will speak to parents about the ELL & Title I curriculum and reading strategies to help the students.
 - Informing parents of child care opportunities in the community through brochures and agencies provided through out the year.
 - The Title III and Migrant Parent Liaison will supply parents with information on social community resources available to them.

D. Accessibility

- Forgan Schools shall provide opportunities for the participation of parents with children with limited English proficiency and parents with children with disabilities, and parents of migratory children, including providing information and school reports in a format and, to the extent practical; in a language such parents can understand. Forgan School shall provide the following:
 - Resources for translation for ELL parents at all conferences and meetings throughout the year, as needed.
 - The services of the guidance counselor and speech language pathologist.
 - Handicap accessible facilities
 - Varied meeting times
